Recycled materials are items that could be found in recycle bins, home, thrift store, etc.

Painting is authorized. You may also use glue, staples, string, etc as fasteners only! Entries should be no larger than 16 inches tall and 18 inches wide.

IMCOM

- Spouse/Family Member Employment:
 - Home Based Business process; E Street Project; Summer Hires; Commissary Bagging; CPAC providing training & local recruiting; ACS Training

- Exchange issues:
 - Last CS survey conducted August; next local survey October 13-20
 - 2012 project to expand clothing area on hold until 2013 (Directed by Exchange Pacific HQ)

- Internet Options:
 - Exchange Telecom working with Garrison; finalizing schedule for fiber installation to improve infrastructure & available services. To be completed by 4th quarter 2012 (Dec)

- Restaurant @ Camp Carroll:
 - Near term: MWR established focus group sessions to determine customer desires on , include new menus/programs, and new décor package on order and seating plan for dining room.
 - The “Hang Out” for the weekends, with special programs and events (Junior Soldiers)

 - Hourly care during normal hours always available
 - Looking for FCC providers to offer great flexibility and employment
