Notice to Residents: Protect Buildings from Freezing

- Keep your room thermostat on heating mode, even when not home
- Set faucets on slow drip to maintain constant water flow to prevent pipes from freezing
- Keep windows and exterior doors closed to reduce heat loss



RESIDENT NOTICE Cautions During the Freezing Season

Please follow the below guidance to protect the Building from Freezing

- 1) Keep your room thermostat on heating mode and set your room temperature to a minimum 60°F (15°C) even when you are not home. Do not completely turn off the heat.
- 2) Set faucets at slow drip (Kitchen & Bathroom) to maintain constant water flow to prevent freezing of cold water lines especially when outside temp drops below 14°F (-10°C).
- 3) Keep your windows and exterior doors closed to reduce heat loss.

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Space Heater Safety



- IAW AK Pam 420-1, Para 2-7, e & f, **“All portable electric heaters require written approval of the DPW prior to use.”**
- Heaters will be UL or FM listed
- Cords and plugs will be in good condition
- Electrical circuitry will automatically shut off if unit is flipped over
- Space heater has been tested to latest safety standards and certified by a nationally recognized testing laboratory
- **NEVER** leave a space heater on when you go to sleep!



SPACE HEATER SAFETY

AK Pam 420-1, Paragraph 2-7, e & f, states, e. "All Portable electric heaters require written approval of the DPW prior to use. These heaters, when permitted, will be UL or FM listed, and will be of the type in which the electrical circuitry is automatically shut off if the unit is tipped over. Power supply cords and plugs will be in good condition, and the supply circuit will be adequate for safe use. NFPA Standard 70, National Electric Code, is the minimum requirement for electrical wiring and equipment. Only authorized electricians will install, repair, and change electrical wiring, fittings, or attachments. f. The use of privately owned space heaters is prohibited in buildings, tents and vehicles."

Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) webpage reports that early this month, 5 children tragically died in a house fire in Florida. Local media reported that a space heater may have sparked the fire.

Sadly, this tragedy is also a reminder to anyone who uses space heaters to keep the following safety dos and don'ts in mind:





Do's:

- Use a space heater that has been tested to the latest safety standards and has been certified by a nationally recognized testing laboratory. These heaters have the most up-to-date safety features. Older space heaters may not meet newer safety standards. Always follow the manufacturer's directions for proper use.
- Place the heater on a level, hard, nonflammable surface, such as a ceramic tile floor.
- Keep the heater at least three feet away from bedding, drapes, furniture, and other flammable materials.
- Keep children and pets away from space heaters.
- Turn the heater off if you leave the area.

Don'ts:

- Never leave a space heater on when you go to sleep.
- Don't place a space heater close to any sleeping person.
- Never use gasoline in a kerosene space heater, as even small amounts of gasoline mixed with kerosene can increase the risk of fire.
- Don't use portable propane space heaters indoors or in any confined space unless they are specifically designed for indoor use.

Also, be sure to place smoke alarms on every level of your home, outside of sleeping areas and inside each bedroom. Guard against carbon monoxide (CO) poisonings as well by installing carbon monoxide alarms in your home. Make sure that your batteries in all alarms are fresh and working.

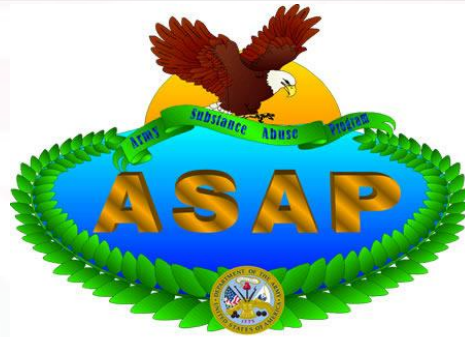

- Claims are accepted from service members within *180 days of separation or retirement*

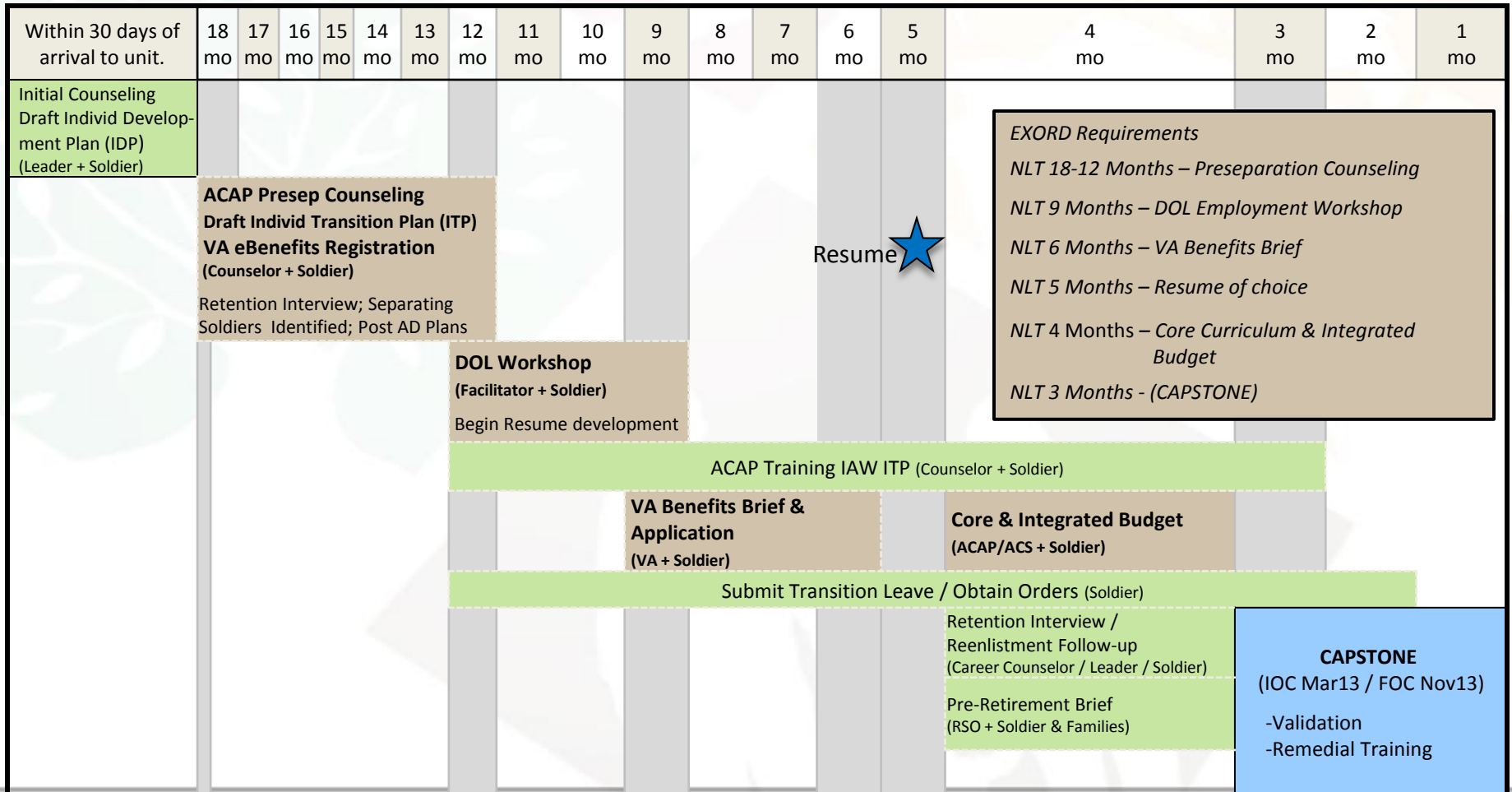

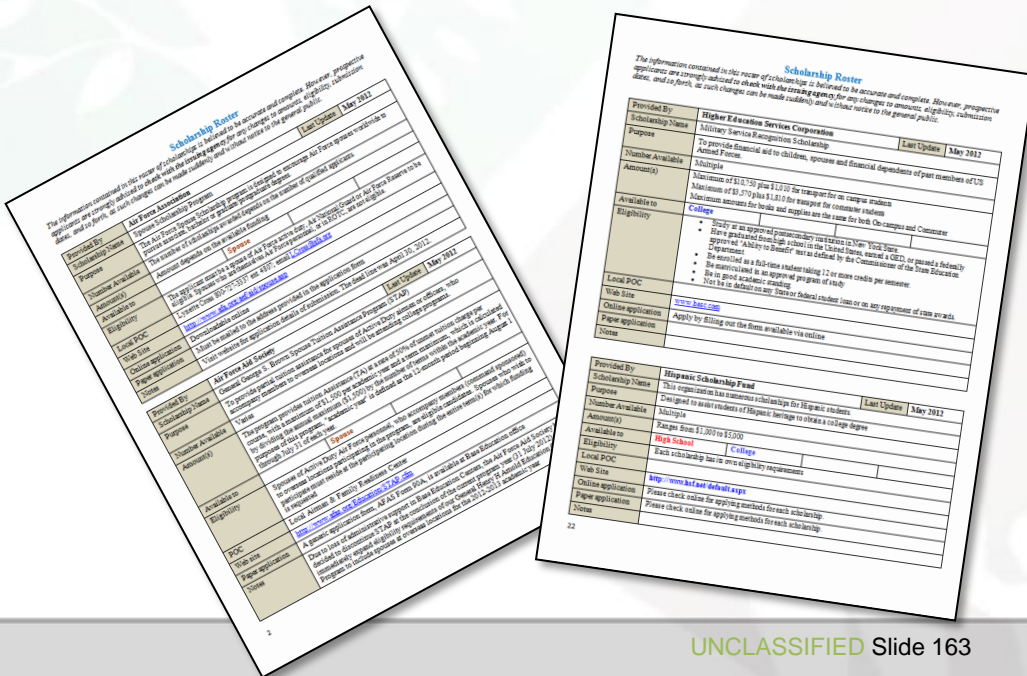

BOSS - Better Opportunities for Single Soldiers

BOSS is a program which supports the overall quality of life for single soldiers, geographical bachelors and single parents. BOSS identifies well being issues and concerns by recommending improvements to the chain of command. The heart of the BOSS program is motivated single soldiers with a strong senior enlisted advisor and guidance from FMWR.

Recreation and Leisure activities may be planned solely by BOSS committee or in conjunction with other FMWR activities. Service members assume the primary role in planning BOSS events and activities. The events should meet the needs and desires of single service members on the installation. BOSS has sponsored events such as talents shows, trips, dances, sporting events and parties.

The BOSS Program participates in many community programs and projects which make a difference in the lives of community members.

BOSS Mission Statement: To enhance the morale and welfare of single soldiers, increase soldier retention, and sustain combat readiness through planned and execution of community service, recreation and leisure events, and identifying well being issues for resolution.

History of BOSS

In 1989, the US Army Community and Family Support Center (USACFSC) and MACOMS were tasked to develop a program to get single soldiers involved in determining their recreation and leisure needs. Implementation of the BOSS program began with single soldiers focus groups. In early workshops, QOL issues emerged along with recreation and leisure needs and were presented to the local command as part of the workshop out-brief.

In 1991, the Chief of Staff, US Army, formally expanded the BOSS program to include all areas of single soldiers' lives. This change provided single soldiers with opportunity to surface quality of life issues through chain of command. During the evolution of the program, single soldiers indicated a desire to participate in activities related to community support; this interest was adopted as another component of the program.

At the 1995 Army-wide BOSS conference, attendees identified the lack of BOSS guidance and program standardization as one of the top five quality of life issues for single soldiers.

In 2000, the US Army changed Quality of Life to "Soldier's Well Being" which encompasses and expands on the concept of Quality of Life. Well being is defined: The personal- physical, material, mental and spiritual- state of Soldiers, retirees, veterans, civilian employees, and their families that contributes to their preparedness to perform the Army's mission.
