Did you know there are services available for your child?

DoDEA provides Special Education and related services to children 3-5 years of age with developmental delays and disabilities. PSCD stands for Preschool Services for Children with Disabilities. Preschoolers with disabilities may receive individually tailored special education and related services in a variety of settings utilizing the appropriate service model for a particular child. If a child qualifies, services are determined by the Case Study Committee and specified on the Individual Education Program (IEP). PSCD is NOT a preschool program. Teachers who provide PSCD services, as well as related service providers, share joint responsibility with the parents of individual children for the child's progress.
