SUBJECT: Nellis Dormitory Policy on Tobacco Use


1. Effective the date of this memorandum, Nellis AFB dormitories are designated smoke-free. In accordance with AFI 40-102, *Tobacco Use in the Air Force*, and for the well being of all dormitory residents, the use of tobacco products is not permitted within the dormitory campus. This includes individual rooms, bathrooms, laundry rooms, day rooms, game rooms and kitchens. Additionally, outside common areas, including grounds, walkways, stairwells and parking lots, are smoke-free; the only acceptable areas are those specifically approved for smoking. The only approved dormitory smoking areas are:

Dormitory 706	Barbeque area of 706
Dormitory 715/725/745	Gazebo located between bldg 715, 725 and 745
Dormitory 727/729	Barbeque area behind bldg 727
Dormitory 767	Barbeque area of bldg 767
Dormitory 777	Barbeque area of bldg 777
Dormitory 782	Barbeque area of bldg 783
Dormitory 786	Barbeque area of bldg 785
Dormitory 792	Barbeque area of bldg 793
Dormitory 794	Barbeque area of bldg 795

2. In areas/circumstances where it is ambiguous as to whether smoking is allowable, the rights of non-smokers prevail.

3. Failure to comply with the spirit and intent of this policy will result in notification to the violator's commander and/or first sergeant for proper disposition IAW UCMJ.
