Dual Polarization Sites

In support of the Dual Polarization Radar deployment, the ROC procured a laptop for each site to be used to support certain Dual Pol maintenance activities. The first 25 laptops were shipped directly from the ROC. As of April 2, 28 additional sites have had laptops shipped from the NLSC. The ROC has the necessary procurement documentation to place these laptops into Sunflower. Once all laptops have been listed in Sunflower, the ROC will begin transferring laptops to each WFO Property Custodian (for NWS Sites). This will likely begin after the conduct of the annual inventory beginning this month.

If you are one of the 25 sites that received your laptop from the ROC, you will be mailed a CD sticker from the ROC, then the ROC will use that CD number and the serial number (recorded prior to shipment) to list the asset in Sunflower. These 25 sites are: Portland, Langley Hill, Pendleton, Spokane, Chicago, Billings, Amarillo, Riverton, NCL Michigan, Cleveland, Atlanta, Goodland, Memphis, Grand Rapids, Seattle, Melbourne, Tucson, NE Alabama, Boston, Dodge City, Brookhaven, Santa Ana Mts., Nashville, Topeka, Key West.

If you are one of the 28 sites that have received a laptop from the NLSC, you must provide the serial number to the ROC prior to receiving a CD sticker from the ROC. The serial numbers are 9 digit numerical beginning with ?107?. These 28 sites are: Philadelphia, Norfolk, Sterling, State College, Buffalo, Binghamton, Knoxville, Miami, Jacksonville, Birmingham, Tampa, Austin/San Antonio, San Angelo, Pleasant Hill, Springfield, St. Louis, Quad Cities, Milwaukee, La Crosse, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Vandenberg AFB, Robins AFB, Edwards AFB, Dover AFB, Beale AFB, Columbus AFB.
