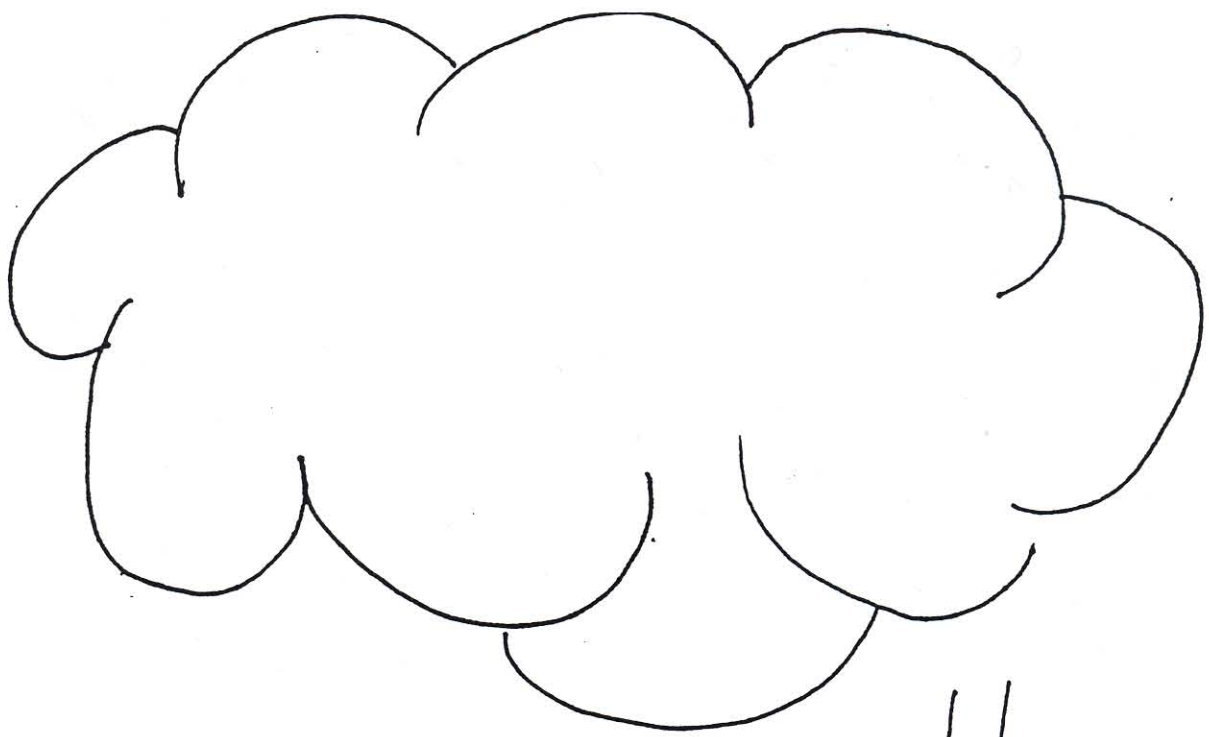


Hi. MY NAME IS H₂O.

I GO DOWN YOUR DRAIN?

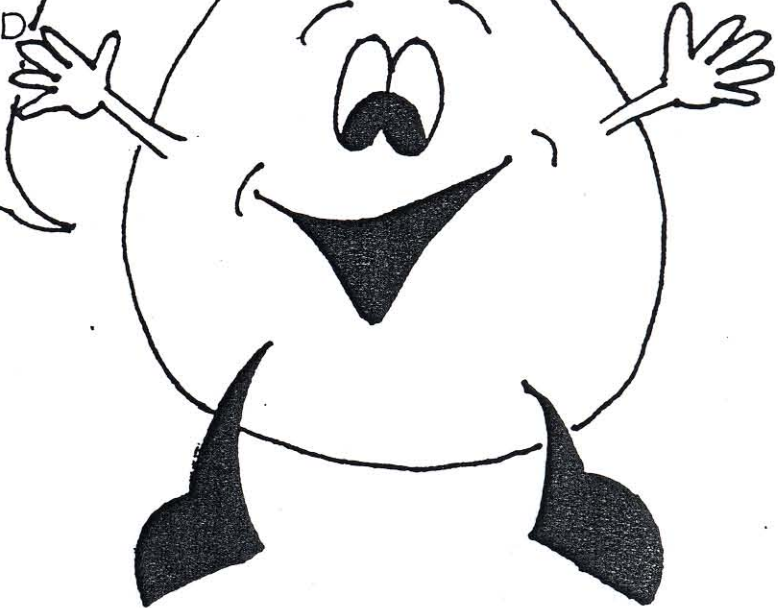


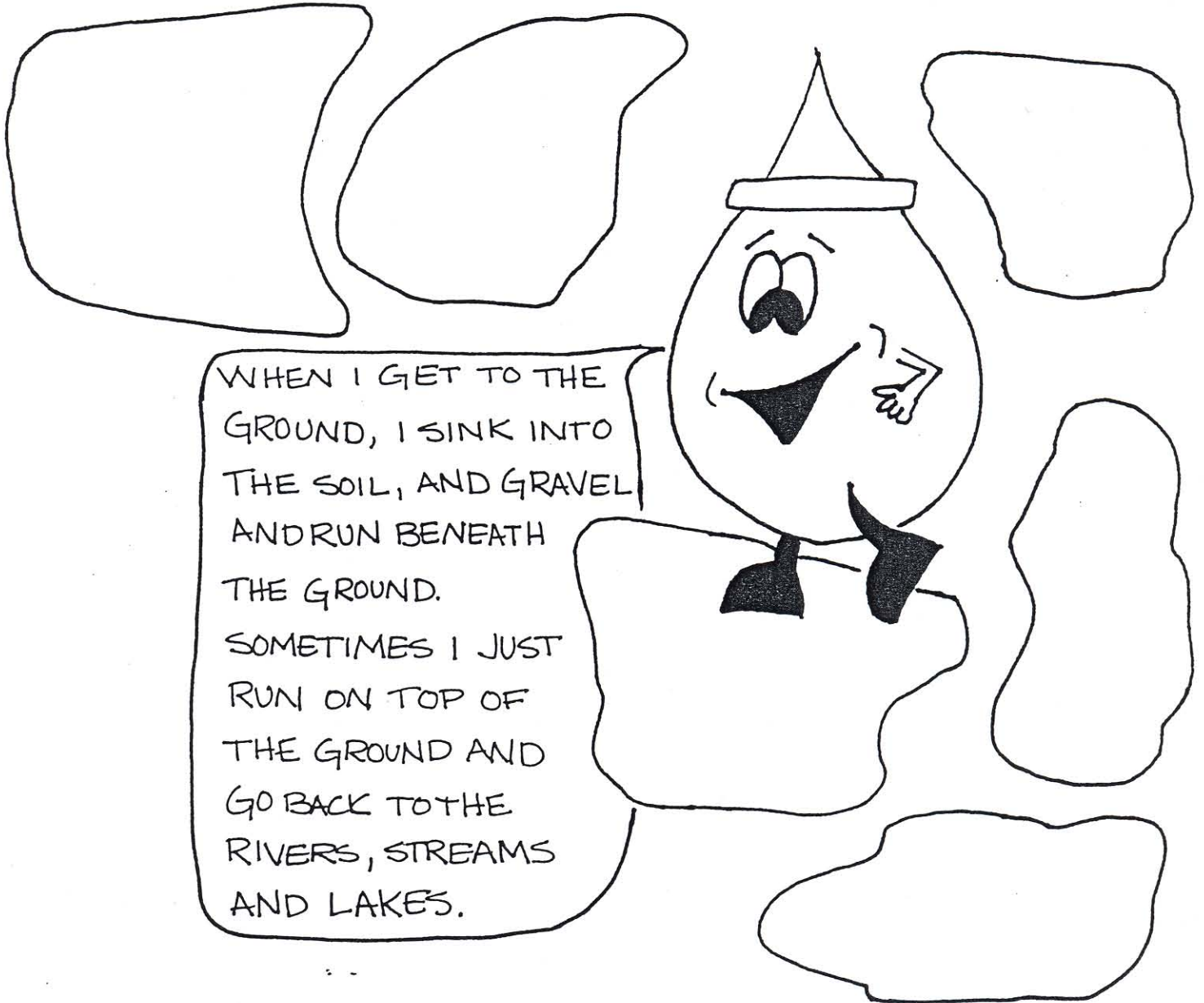
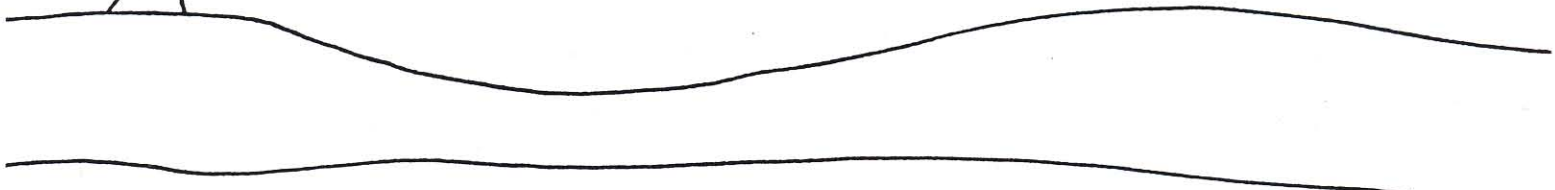
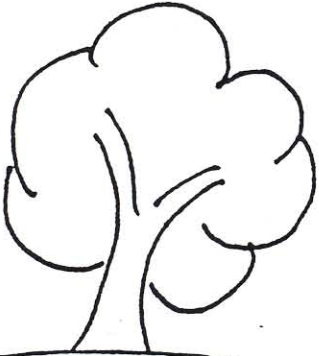
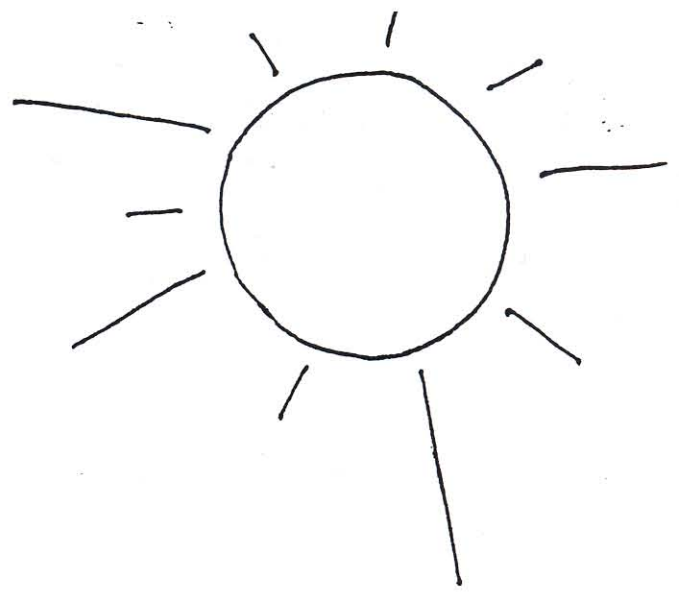
WHEN THE SUN

INTO A CLOUD.






WHEN IT RAINS,

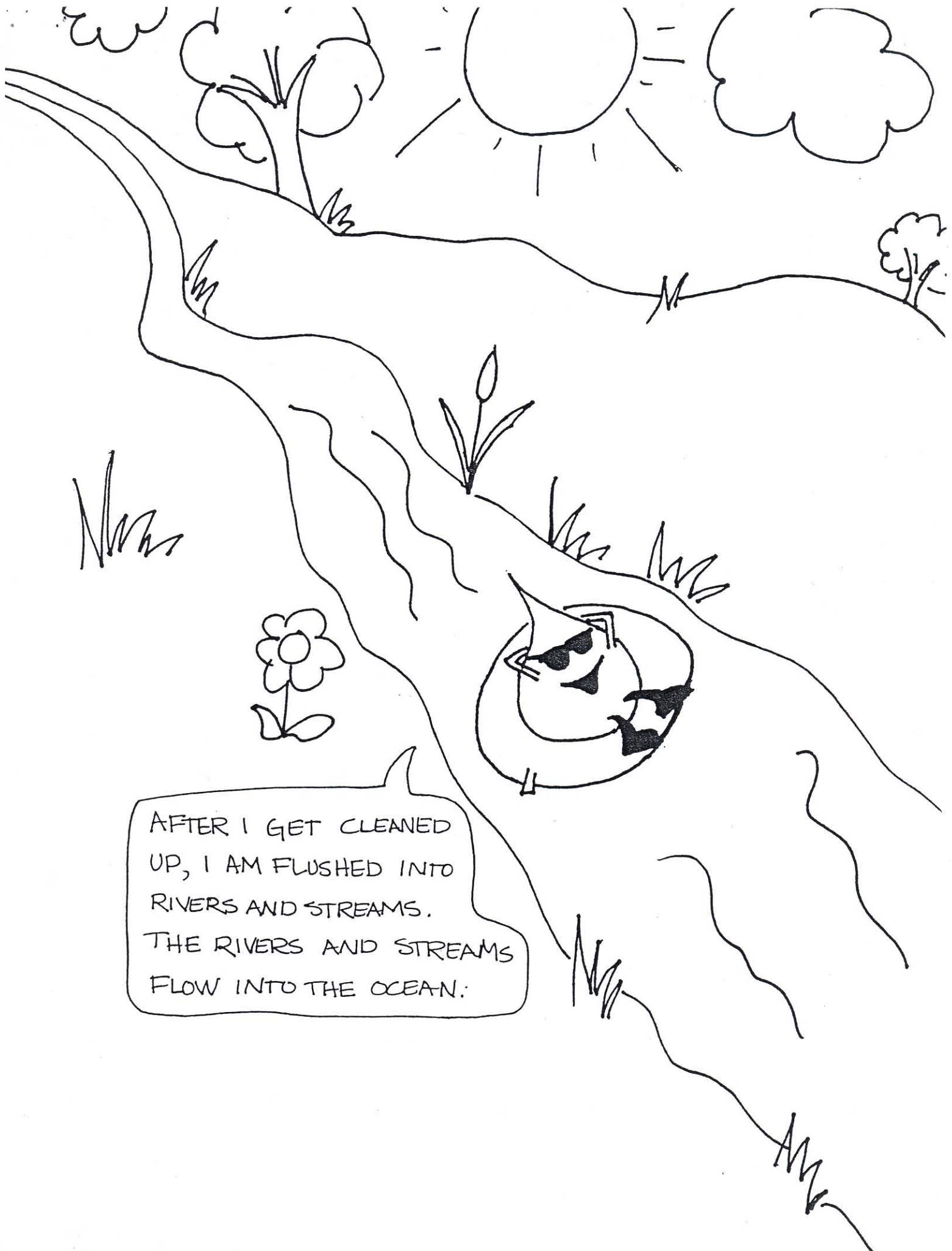
