- **\$2.0M** committed by the State for South Polk Elementary renovations. Project began 27 May 2011; estimated completion Summer 2011.
- **\$21.5M** Bond Issue committed for Leesville High School modernization and renovations
- **\$5.95M** Federal Impact Aid for Vernon Parish Schools
- **\$2.0M** Grant from DOD Education Activity (DODEA) for Vernon Parish Schools
- **\$100K** from DODEA for contracted school liaison
- **Military Family Life Consultants (MFLCs)** - 5 MFLCs in 7 Vernon Parish Schools

- **\$100-150K** DoD Office of Economic Adjustment committed to hire planner for Growth Management Plan
- **\$59K** to fund and staff Fort Polk Progress (FPP): \$30K from Vernon Parish, \$25K from Leesville, and \$4K from Anacoco
- **\$230K** committed by VP Police Jury / Center for Planning Excellence / VP Tourism Commission for development of the Vernon Parish Comprehensive Plan
- **\$150K** received from the Louisiana Office of Community Development to develop a Capital Improvements Plan as part of the VP Comprehensive Plan
- **\$50K** investment by VP Police Jury for baseline GIS mapping; working with VP Tax Assessor and other parish agencies to complete parcel level GIS mapping for parish.
- Louisiana Economic Development - under contract with Technomic, food industry consulting and research for the recruitment of restaurants / retail
- CENLA Chamber working with 3-4 prospects to bring business/ employment to Fort Polk area - jobs for spouses

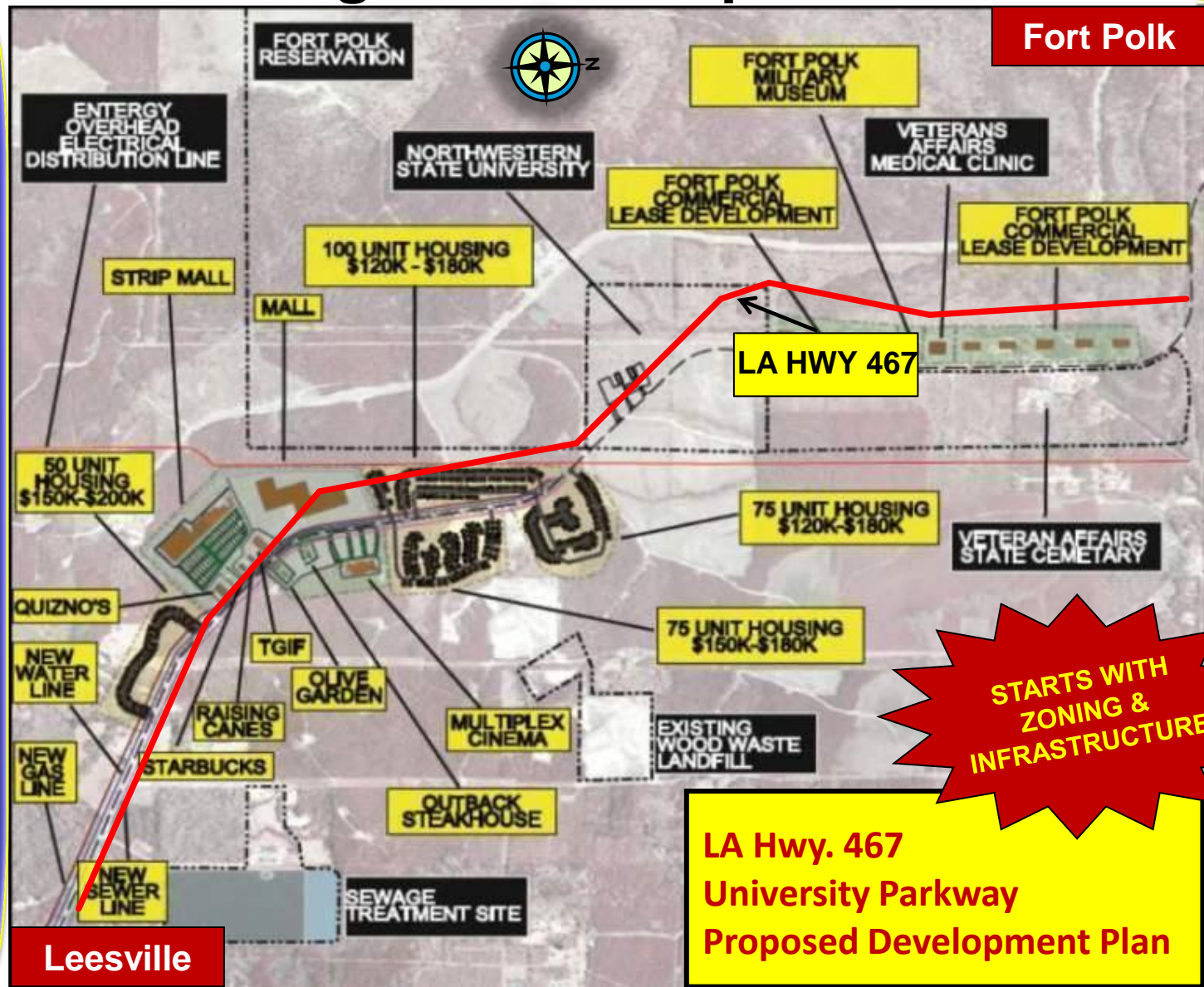
Transportation

- **\$600K** funded by Louisiana Dept. of Trans. & Development to develop Vernon Parish Transportation Plan
- **\$20.0M** funded for US 171 reconstruction of concrete and asphalt
- **\$26.9M** final leg of Hwy 28 under construction: (strategic corridor to England Airpark). Total from Leesville to Alexandria - \$134M
- **\$2.2M** Roundabout at LA Highway 28 / US Hwy 171; estimated completion - Jul 2011
- I-14 Project - Proposed Gulf Coast Strategic Highway



Joint Targeted Development

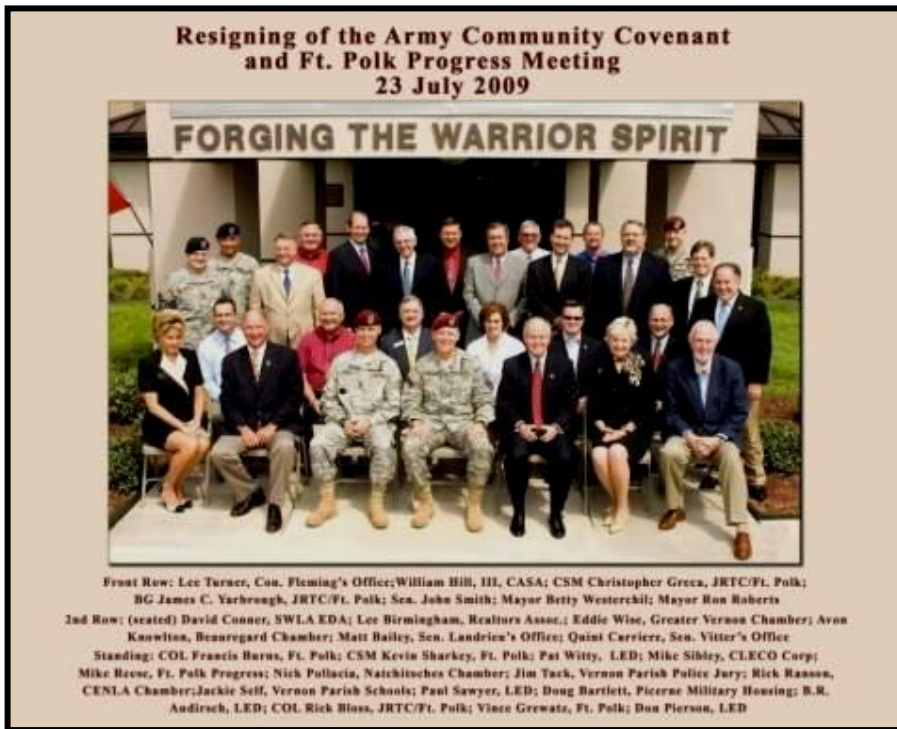
- **\$25.2M** State Investment to grow Fort Polk area
- **\$75M** long-term growth plan with a **\$10.6M** “kick-start”
- **\$4.9M** wastewater trunk line (5 mi.)
- **\$5.7M** Hwy 467 realignment
- use NSU Campus, VA Cemetery as a base for future construction – State will partner





Army Community Covenant

- Land Purchase Program includes a 100,000-acre expansion
- Alexandria International Airport has scheduled \$20 million in improvements
- Vernon Parish Comprehensive Master Plan: Vernon Parish Police Jury has matched a \$120K grant to develop a plan for land use, infrastructure requirements, housing and transportation
- \$600K received from State for transportation & infrastructure improvements
- Louisiana has joined Interstate Compact for military children
- Vernon Parish has received \$2 million DoD grant to aid military children over the next 3 years for all 6 schools
- Superintendent of Schools pursuing funding for new facility for Leesville High school
- Vernon Schools have received stimulus funding to increase technology capabilities
