Public-Safety Broadband Demo Network Meeting Set for March (2/1/12)

The federal Public Safety Communications Research (PSCR) program will hold its third 700 MHz public-safety broadband demonstration network stakeholder meeting March 6 – 7 at the Omni Interlocken Resort and Hotel near Boulder, Colo.

Participants will learn about progress in PSCR's demonstration network testing, including:

- Phase one test results and lessons learned;
- Current study item findings;

- Nationwide broadband modeling and simulation efforts and results being conducted by NIST.
