- Complete all the second grade standards on IXL.com (Your child has a username and password and can continue to use IXL during the summer.)
- Know how to form printed letters and numbers going from top to bottom, left to right; form "o" by making a letter "c" and closing it.
- Be able to write a complete sentence.
- Know home phone number
- Be able to sit still, take turns, and be kind.
