

Code of Federal Regulations structure.

The basic structure of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) consists of a hierarchy of designated CFR units. The CFR numbering system is **not** based on a decimal numbering system.

The following table illustrates the CFR structure.

CFR Unit	CFR Designation	Description
Title	50	Broad area subject to Federal regulation
Chapter	VI	Rules of issuing agency
Part	622	Rules on a single program or function
Section	622.1	One provision of program/function rules
Paragraph	622.1(a)	Detailed, specific requirements
