The Air Force officer qualifying test will be offered on Friday morning of the January drill at 8 a.m. hours all test participants must be in their seats NLT 0745. This test takes 4½ hours and is administered by the education office to measure aptitudes used to select candidates for officer commissioning programs and specific commissioned officer training programs.
