# **RECOGNITIONS (DELETED):**

GOOD AFTERNOON. IS THIS A HOOAH DAY IN HUNTSVILLE/MADISON COUNTY OR WHAT?

DEBRA (WYMER), THANK YOU FOR THAT KIND INTRODUCTION AND CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR ELECTION AND BOB (POLLARD) CONGRATULATIONS TO YOU AND THANKS FOR YOUR SERVICE TO THE ASSOCIATION, WELL DONE.

AS YOU SAW IN MY BIO, I WAS BORN AND RAISED IN CHESHIRE CONNECTICUT. I HAD NO INCLINATION TO JOIN THE ARMY. I JOINED ROTC AS RESULT OF A JUNK MAIL THAT I RECEIVED IN HIGH SCHOOL.

SO, IF YOU WOULD HAVE TOLD ME, 37 ½ YEARS AGO, THAT I'D BE STANDING HERE – IN HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA AS THE COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE COMMAND / ARMY FORCES STRATEGIC COMMAND AND COMMANDER OF THE JOINT FUNCTIONAL COMPONENT COMMAND FOR INTEGRATED MISSILE DEFENSE – ADDRESSING A GATHERING OF 400+ GOVERNMENT, CIVIC AND

INDUSTRY LEADERS INTERESTED IN SPACE AND MISSILE
DEFENSE – I WOULD NEVER HAVE BELIEVED YOU IN A MILLION
YEARS!

BUT, HERE I AM – AND IT'S MY HONOR TO BE HERE TO TALK TO YOU TODAY.

FIRST, I'D LIKE TO THANK YOU AND THE ASSOCIATION FOR ALL THAT YOU DO FOR OUR SOLDIERS AND CIVILIANS – AND FOR THE GOOD THAT YOU DO IN SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE. I WAS PARTICULARLY IMPRESSED BY YOUR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM WHEN I WAS HERE FOR THE SMD CONFERENCE THIS PAST AUGUST. WE'RE THANKFUL FOR ASMDA'S CO-SPONSORSHIP OF THAT CONFERENCE WITH NDIA, ADA ASSOCIATION, AND SMDC/ARSTRAT. AND, WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO THIS YEAR'S CONFERENCE IN AUGUST.

I'D LIKE TO ADD MY CONGRATULATIONS TO THE AWARDEES, GOVERNMENT AND CONTRACTOR, REPRESENTING MDA, NASA, MSIC, SMDC AND OTHERS WHO WERE RECOGNIZED A FEW MOMENTS AGO. I'D LIKE TO ADD MY CONGRATULATIONS FOR WHAT YOU CONTRIBUTE TO SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE. CONGRATULATIONS.

TODAY I'D LIKE TO BRIEFLY COVER THREE THINGS – FIRST I'D LIKE TO TALK A LITTLE BIT ABOUT OUR ARMY. SECOND, ABOUT SMDC AND MY VISION FOR THE COMMAND, AND THIRD – A LITTLE OF WHAT'S IN FRONT OF US FOR THE NEXT 12-18 MONTHS OR SO.

## **ARMY**

OUR ARMY IS PERFORMING MAGNIFICENTLY ALONG SIDE OUR NAVY, AIR FORCE, MARINES AND COALITION PARTNERS IN CRITICAL OPERATIONS IN AFGHANISTAN, IRAQ AND ACROSS THE GLOBE.

TODAY THE ARMY HAS SOME 231,000 SOLDIERS DEPLOYED ACROSS THE GLOBE WITH SOME 118,000 IN OPERATIONS IN THE CENTCOM AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY. OUR SOLDIERS ARE FOCUSED – AND THEY'RE MAKING PROGRESS EVERY DAY UNDER TOUGH TACTICAL CONDITIONS.

THEY UNDERSTAND THE MEANING OF SERVICE AND THEY UNDERSTAND SACRIFICE. WHEN I WAS SERVING IN AFGHANISTAN – I WOULD BE AWED TO GO TO SOME OF THE REMOTE LOCATIONS AND VISIT WITH OUR SOLDIERS WHO WERE SERVING THERE OFTEN TIMES CO-LOCATED WITH AFGHAN NATIONAL SECURITY FORCES. AT SOME OF THE MOST REMOTE LOCATIONS, THESE TROOPS WOULD WASH THEIR UNDERWEAR IN BUCKETS FOR THREE WEEKS AT A TIME. THEY'D GET MAIL ONCE A WEEK – IF THE HELICOPTER DROP WAS AVAILABLE – AND EVERY NOW AND THEN, THEY WOULD GET A CHANCE TO GO TO AN AUSTERE FORWARD OPERATING BASE FOR CONVENIENCES; LIKE LAUNDRY AND A HOT MEAL, WASHING THEIR CLOTHES, GETTING TO THE PX. NOT ONE TIME DID A SOLDIER COMPLAIN TO ME WHEN THEY WERE LIVING IN THESE CONDITIONS. THEY FELT GOOD ABOUT WHAT IT IS THEY WERE DOING. THEY UNDERSTAND, AND

UNDERSTOOD SERVICE AND SACRIFICE. AND, IT'S TO THESE SOLDIERS TO WHOM WE COMMIT TO PROVIDING TIMELY, RELEVANT CAPABILITIES.

NO DOUBT THE ARMY IS STRETCHED AFTER A DECADE AT WAR – SUSTAINING TWO MAJOR OPERATIONS WHILE CONTINUING A GLOBAL PRESENCE AND PARTICIPATING IN STABILITY OPERATIONS AND TRAINING EXERCISES AROUND THE WORLD. OUR SOLDIERS AND FAMILIES FEEL THE STRAIN OF MULTIPLE DEPLOYMENTS – YET RETENTION AND REENLISTMENT RATES ARE GOOD; ENLISTMENT GOALS ARE BEING MET; OUR SOLDIERS AND FAMILIES REMAIN FOCUSED ON THEIR MISSION; DWELL TIME INBETWEEN ROTATIONS IS INCREASING; MORALE IS GOOD – AND THERE'S AN ENORMOUS SENSE OF PRIDE IN WHAT WE'RE ACCOMPLISHING.

## **SMDC VISION**

LET ME TAKE SOME TIME TO TALK ABOUT THE COMMAND.

AGAIN, IT'S AN HONOR FOR ME TO HAVE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO

SERVE IN THIS VERY IMPORTANT COMMAND.

OUR OPERATIONAL VISION STATEMENT RECOGNIZES THAT:

- WE ARE A DIVERSE, COMPLEX AND GLOBAL COMMAND THAT PROVIDES CRITICAL CAPABILITIES TO OUR ARMY, TO US STRATEGIC COMMAND, TO THE GEOGRAPHIC COMBATANT COMMANDERS, AND THEIR ARMY SERVICE COMPONENT COMMANDERS. AND THAT WE MUST REMAIN IN SYNCH WITH

- STRATCOM'S JOINT FUNCTIONAL COMPONENT COMMAND FOR INTEGRATED MISSILE DEFENSE (JFCC-IMD).
- IT RECOGNIZES THAT WE ARE ONE COMMAND. WE ARE SPLIT BASED WITH PART OF THE HEADQUARTERS HERE IN HUNTSVILLE AND PART IN COLORADO SPRINGS BUT WE ARE ONE COMMAND; AND WE ARE MULTI-COMPONENT ACTIVE, GUARD, AND RESERVE;
  - WE'RE DIVERSE WE HAVE SOLDIERS AND CIVILIANS

    OPERATING AROUND THE GLOBE IN DISPERSED LOCATIONS –

    AND WE CONSIST OF A TALENTED AND PROFESSIONAL WORK

    FORCE OF SOLDIERS, CIVILIANS AND CONTRACTORS ALL

    OF WHOM MUST BE PUBLIC SERVANTS
- AS THE ARMY'S PROPONENT FOR SPACE, HIGH ALTITUDE,
  AND GLOBAL MISSILE DEFENSE AND AS THE ARMY'S
  OPERATIONAL INTEGRATOR FOR GLOBAL MISSILE DEFENSE,
  WE HAVE 3 CORE TASKS:
  - FIRST, TO PROVIDE TRAINED AND READY SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE FORCES AND CAPABILITIES TO THE COMBATANT COMMANDERS AND TO THE WARFIGHTER
  - SECOND, TO BUILD FUTURE SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE FORCES
  - AND THIRD, TO RESEARCH, TEST, AND INTEGRATE SPACE, MISSILE DEFENSE, DIRECTED ENERGY, AND RELATED TECHNOLOGIES

- I DEVIATE FROM THE VISION STATEMENT TO SAY THAT WE ARE UNIQUELY ORGANIZED TO EXECUTE THOSE THREE TASKS WITH RDA - TO DO MATERIEL DEVELOPMENT: FUTURE WARFARE CENTER – TO DO CAPABILITY DEVELOPMENT. AND OPERATIONS GROUP WITH TWO BRIGADES. ONE MISSILE DEFENSE BRIGADE, A SPACE BRIGADE AND HEADQUARTERED IN COLORADO SPRINGS, BUT WITH ELEMENTS AROUND THE WORLD. AND WE ARE GEOGRAPHICALLY WELL-POSITIONED FOR OUR THREE TASKS. HERE IN HUNTSVILLE WE'RE CO-LOCATED WITH MDA. AMC/AMCOM, PEO MISSILES AND SPACE, PEO AVIATION, AND WITH NASA -- AND THE OUTSTANDING TECH BASE HERE IN HUNTSVILLE. IN COLORADO SPRINGS WE ARE CO-LOCATED WITH MDA, WITH NORTHCOM, US AIR FORCE SPACE COMMAND AND WITH AGAIN WITH THE PARTICULARLY SPACE-ORIENTED TECH BASE THERE IN COLORADO SPRINGS.
- OUR VISION STATEMENT ALSO RECOGNIZES THAT WE MUST SUSTAIN CLOSE AND COLLABORATIVE RELATIONSHIPS WITH MDA AND WITH THE MANY ARMY, JOINT, CIVIC AND INDUSTRY PARTNERS THAT WE'RE COL-LOCATED WITH AND THAT WE COMMIT TO HERE IN THIS COMMUNITY. MANY OF YOU REPRESENT THAT CLOSE COLLABORATION.
- IT ALSO RECOGNIZES TAT WE MUST BE NESTED WITHIN THE ARMY'S ENTERPRISE FRAMEWORK AND THAT AS A COMMAND WE WILL EMBED SOLDIERS INTO THE

- HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY'S AIR AND MISSILE DEFENSE (AMD) TASK FORCE.
- WE WILL SUSTAIN A UNIQUE RELATIONSHIP WITH ARMY CYBER, WHICH AS YOU KNOW WAS BIRTHED OUT OF SMDC, WE WERE TEMPORARILY ARMY CYBER FOR OUR ARMY. WE'VE NOW STOOD THAT ORGANIZATION UP AND WE HAVE AN EXPECTATION THAT WE WILL MAINTAIN A UNIQUE RELATIONSHIP WITH IT, PROVIDING SUPPORT TO THE COMMAND AS IT BUILDS TO AND ACHIEVES FULL OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY (FOC) AND THEN WE'LL NEED TO RETAIN CLOSE ORGANIZATIONAL LINKAGES WITH IT THEREAFTER.
- OUR ORGANIZATIONAL VISION STATEMENT RECOGNIZES
  THAT WE WILL BE DISCIPLINED STEWARDS OF OUR
  GOVERNMENT'S RESOURCES. WE WILL BE ACCOUNTABLE
  FOR OUR PROGRAMS AND WE'LL REFLECT A COST CULTURE
  IN ALL THAT WE DO. THIS WILL BE PARTICULARLY
  IMPORTANT IN AN ENVIRONMENT OF TIGHT BUDGETS AND
  WITH TODAY'S FISCAL REALITIES.
- WE WILL HAVE PRECISE, CONFIDENT, FIT, DISCIPLINED, AND COURAGEOUS SOLDIERS AND CIVILIANS WHO ARE LED BY TOUGH, COMPETENT, CARING, AND COURAGEOUS LEADERS AND WE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE AND COOPERATIVE TENANTS AT REDSTONE ARSENAL, PETERSON AIR FORCE BASE AND

ON THE INSTALLATIONS ON WHICH WE LIVE AND SERVE. AND WE WILL BE GOOD NEIGHBORS.

- AND FINALLY, OUR VISION STATEMENT RECOGNIZES THAT
WE ARE A VALUES-BASED COMMAND – WHICH CARES FOR
AND SERVES OUR SOLDIERS, CIVILIANS AND FAMILIES IN THE
COMMAND.

NOW WE'RE IN THE PROCESS OF ESTABLISHING OUR COMMAND'S TOP PRIORITIES FOR THE NEXT SEVERAL MONTHS. WE'RE GOING TO REFINE THESE AS WE GO ON, AND WE'LL ADJUST THEM. BUT, I THOUGHT I'D SHARE THEM WITH YOU IN THEIR CURRENT STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT.

#### **SMDC PRIORITIES**

OUR PRIORITIES ARE ALIGNED AGAINST OUR THREE CORE TASKS:

THE PRIORITIES THAT ARE ALIGNED WITH OUR FIRST TASK OF PROVIDING TRAINED AND READY SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE FORCES:

- FIRST IS TO IMPROVE THE OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY TO SUPPORT COMBATANT COMMANDERS, OUR TRAINING PROGRAMS, AND OUR QUALITY OF LIFE FOR OUR SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE FORCES...PARTICULARLY QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THOSE AT KWAJALEIN ISLAND AND AT FORT GREELY, ALASKA

- SECOND, WE'LL PROVIDE SPACE FORCES AND CAPABILITIES
  TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS THAT ARE COMING OUT OF
  THEATER
- AND THIRD, WE MUST TAKE CARE OF OUR DEPLOYED SOLDIERS AND THEIR FAMILIES AND OUR SOLDIERS THAT HAVE REDEPLOYED AND THEIR FAMILIES.

FOR OUR SECOND TASK : BUILDING FUTURE SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE FORCES OUR PRIORITIES ARE

- TO CONTINUE THE INTEGRATION OF THE AN/TPY-2 RADARS AND C2BMC SYSTEMS THAT WILL GO INTO OUR FORCE (PART OF THE MDA BMDS SYSTEM) SO THAT WE CAN ENSURE THEY HAVE THEIR DOCTRINE, ORGANIZATION, MANNING AND TRAINING WITHIN THE ARMY ON TRACK.
- WE WILL EXECUTE OUR PROPONENCY FUNCTIONS ACROSS DOCTRINE, ORGANIZATION, TRAINING, MATERIEL, LEADERSHIP, PERSONNEL, AND FACILITIES (DOTMLPF) AS WE CONDUCT OPERATIONAL EXPERIMENTS, FORCE ON FORCE MODELING AND SIMULATION, AND MILITARY UTILITY AND OPERATIONAL ANALYSES IN THE NEXT SEVERAL MONTHS.
- OUR FOCUS FOR THOSE IN THE NEAR TERM IS ON EMERGING SPACE, HIGH ALTITUDE, AND LONG ENDURANCE MULTI-INTELLIGENCE VEHICLE (LEMV) CAPABILITIES, JTAGS PRE-PLANNED PRODUCT IMPROVEMENT (P3I), AND SPACE SUPERIORITY CAPABILITY DEVELOPMENT.

ASSOCIATED WITH OUR THIRD TASK OF RESEARCHING, TESTING, AND INTEGRATING SPACE, MISSILE DEFENSE, DIRECTED ENERGY, AND RELATED TECHNOLOGIES THERE ARE TWO PRIORITIES:

- THE FIRST, TO DEVELOP AND MATURE TECHNOLOGIES TO TRANSITION THE MOST CAPABILITIES, AS RAPIDLY AS POSSIBLE, AT A FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: HIGH ALTITUDE, LEMV, HIGH ENERGY LASER PROGRAM, NANO-SATELLITES, ADVANCED HYPERSONIC WEAPON-PROMPT GLOBAL STRIKE (AHW-PGS), CYBERSPACE, COUNTER-IED, AND SOME OTHER RELATED TECHNOLOGIES ARE ON TOP OF OUR PRIORITY LIST.
- ALSO ESTABLISHED AS A PRIORITY THIS YEAR TO
  TRANSFER BASE OPERATIONS SUPPORT OF US ARMY
  KWAJALEIN ATOLL (USAKA) TO THE US ARMY INSTALLATION
  MANAGEMENT COMMAND. AND THEN, AS THE ARMY'S SENIOR
  COMMANDER FOR THAT INSTALLATION, OUR ROLE WILL BE
  TO FOCUS OUR RESOURCES AND ENERGY ON RANGE
  OPERATIONS AND MISSION TASKS SO THAT WE CAN
  CONTINUE TO MAINTAIN THE REAGAN TEST SITE AS A
  PREMIER RANGE FOR SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE
  TESTING.

AND, THEN FINALLY, ACROSS ALL THREE OF OUR TASKS, OUR FINAL PRIORITY IS TO RECRUIT, DEVELOP, AND RETAIN A HIGH PERFORMING CIVILIAN WORKFORCE AND MILITARY TEAM.

#### **NEXT 12-18 MONTHS**

- SO, WITH THOSE PRIORITIES GUIDING US WE HAVE A BUSY YEAR AHEAD. I'D LIKE TO MENTION A FEW OF THE MAJOR EVENTS THAT I SEE ON THE HORIZON:
  - FIRST, WE WILL CONTINUE TO DEPLOY SPACE
    SUPPORT AND COMMERCIAL IMAGERY TEAMS TO MEET THE
    REQUIREMENTS IN THEATER. WE HAVE OVER 1,300 SOLDIERS
    AND CIVILIANS IN OPERATIONAL FORCES EITHER STATIONED
    IN CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES AND ALASKA AS PART OF
    THE BMDS SYSTEM OR FORWARD STATIONED IN LOCATIONS
    AROUND THE GLOBE OR DEPLOYED TO THEATER. THIS
    COMING APRIL TWO MORE OF OUR SPACE SUPPORT TEAMS
    WILL DEPLOY TO THEATER. THEY'RE IN TRAINING WITH THEIR
    UNITS THAT THEY ARE GOING TO DEPLOY WITH AT FORT
    HOOD, TEXAS AND IN THE SECOND MARINE EXPEDITIONARY
    FORCE, AS WE SPEAK TODAY.
  - OUR MISSILE DEFENSE FORCES WILL REMAIN ON STATION AND READY TO EXECUTE BOTH IN CALIFORNIA AND

CURRENTLY IN THE BELOW ZERO TEMPERATURES OF ALASKA.

- OUR WIDEBAND SATELLITE OPERATION CENTERS
  (WSOC) AND JTAGS ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN ON STATION
  PROVIDING 24/7 SATELLITE CONTROL AND MISSILE WARNING
  SUPPORT TO GEOGRAPHIC COMBATANT COMMANDERS. WE
  RECENTLY MOVED ONE OF OUR WIDE BAND SATELLITE
  OPERATIONS CENTERS (WSOC) FROM CALIFORNIA TO
  HAWAII. IT HAS ACHIEVED INITIAL OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY
  ALREADY AND WILL ACHIEVE FULL OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY
  BY APRIL.
- OUR ASTRONAUTS WILL CONTINUE THEIR LEGACY OF SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION IN OUR NATION'S HUMAN SPACE FLIGHT PROGRAMS. LTC ROBERT KIMBROUGH IS ALREADY ASSIGNED TO A LONG DURATION MISSION ABOARD THE INTERNATIONAL SPACE STATION SCHEDULED TO LAUNCH IN FALL 2012.
- WE WILL CONTINUE THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR NANOSATELLITE SMDC-ONE WHICH IS SCHEDULED FOR ITS NEXT LAUNCH IN EARLY 2012. AND THE FIRST LAUNCH OF KESTREL EYE, ANOTHER NANO-SATELLITE WHICH WILL CARRY AN ISR (INTELLIGENCE, SURVEILLANCE, AND RECONNAISSANCE) PAYLOAD IS ALSO SCHEDULED DEPLOY IN EARLY 2012.

- THE JOINT HIGH POWER SOLID STATE LASER WILL
  MOVE FROM CALIFORNIA TO WHITE SANDS MISSILE RANGE
  BEGINNING IN MARCH, WILL BECOME OPERATIONAL THERE IN
  AUGUST, AND WILL HAVE ITS FIRST TEST BY SEPTEMBER.
- THE HIGH ALTITUDE LONG ENDURANCE DEMONSTRATION (HALE-D) IS ON TRACK FOR JUNE 2011.
- LEMV DEVELOPMENT CONTINUES AND IS ON PATH FOR ITS FIRST SYSTEM FLIGHT THIS SUMMER WITH A DEPLOYMENT FOR JOINT MILITARY UTILITY ASSESSMENT IN EARLY 2012.
- AND WE HAVE SEVERAL MAJOR ACQUISITIONS
  PLANNED FOR RELEASE IN THE NEXT FEW MONTHS.
  SYSTEMS ENGINEERING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
  CONTRACT, OR SETAC, THE DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT,
  DEMONSTRATION AND INTEGRATION OR D3I, ARMY SPACE
  AND MISSILE DEFENSE TECHNOLOGY EXPERIMENTATION,
  RESEARCH, OPERATIONS, IMPLEMENTATION AND
  DEVELOPMENT CONTRACT (ASTROID). EACH OF THESE
  ACTIONS WILL PROVIDE A SIGNIFICANT CAPABILITY TO
  SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR TECHNOLOGIES.
- WE WILL PARTICIPATE IN 13 MAJOR EXERCISES THIS YEAR.
  IN APRIL WE WILL PARTICIPATE IN STRATCOM'S GLOBAL
  LIGHTNING AND GLOBAL THUNDER IN OCTOBER..... WE WILL
  PARTICIPATE IN 12 OTHER EXERCISES PROVIDING SPACEBASED COMMUNICATIONS, INTELLIGENCE, BALLISTIC MISSILE

EARLY WARNING, ARMY SPACE SUPPORT TEAMS, AND COMMERCIAL IMAGERY IN SUPPORT OF EACH OF THE GEOGRAPHIC COMBATANT COMMANDERS.

- WE HAVE SEVERAL ENGAGEMENTS WITH JFCC-IMD TO INCLUDE GLOBAL THUNDER/LIGHTENING AND OTHER EXERCISES SUCH AS: NIMBLE TITAN WHICH IS AN INTERNATIONAL MISSILE DEFENSE EXERCISE SERIES; EUCOM'S AUSTERE CHALLENGE; AND TERMINAL FURY WITH PACOM IN MAY.

#### CONFERENCES

NOW AS YOU KNOW, THERE ARE A LOT OF CONFERENCES IN THE SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE ARENA. BUT, IT'S IMPORTANT TO ME THAT THE COMMAND SCRUTINIZES OUR PARTICIPATION IN EACH CONFERENCE – AND FOCUSES ON THOSE WHERE WE CAN ACHIEVE OUR MOST IMPORTANT OBJECTIVES. WE CAN'T AND WON'T ATTEND THEM ALL.

AMONG THOSE THAT WE WILL KEY IN ON, NOT THE ONLY ONE'S WE'LL PARTICIPATE IN, BUT, THE ONE'S WE'LL KEY IN ON INCLUDE MDA'S 9<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL MISSILE DEFENSE CONFERENCE IN D.C.
