SUBJECT: US Army Garrison (USAG) Daegu Policy Letter #30 - Trash on USAG Daegu and Area IV Installations

- 1. This policy is effective immediately. It remains in effect until rescinded or superseded.
- 2. This policy applies to all USAG Daegu and Area IV Base Operations Staff, Mission Partner Units, Soldiers, Civilian, Korean National (KN), Contractors, Family members, Authorized Private Organizations, and Authorized Visitors.
- 3. All on-post trash bins, receptacles and dumpsters are reserved for on-post offices, Unaccompanied Personnel Housing, Army Family Housing and official authorized agencies use. Users will make every effort to segregate on-post trash into recyclable and non recyclable containers as appropriate.
- 4. Under no circumstances are personnel (Soldier, Civilian, Contractor, KN, and Family members) who reside off-post to utilize any on-post trash containers, bins, or dumpsters for their off-post trash. Personnel residing off-post will adhere to and utilize Host Nation Trash Segregation and Recycling Program in accordance with their established lease. All personnel residing off-post must work with their landlords concerning trash removal.
- 5. All personnel residing off-post are welcomed and encouraged to utilize on-post recycle containers for recyclables such as: paper, plastics, glass, cardboard and aluminum. Monies generated through the on-post Qualitative Management Recycling Program are used to maintain the program and provides funds to Morale Welfare and Recreation (MWR).
- 6. Personnel caught violating this policy may be subjected to adverse administrative actions that may include, Letter of Warning, Suspension of Driving Privileges, etc as determine by USAG Daegu Garrison Commander.
