

Wildlife Restoration Account Apportioned for Hunter Education -Funds remaining in Section 4 (c) **Apportioned for Hunter** Wildlife Restoration Account 1/2 of taxes collected on pistols, **Education - Section 10** after deductions revolvers, bows, quivers, \$8 million set aside **Apportioned** broadheads, shafts for Wildlife Restoration Section 4 (c) and Section 10 50% number of paid licensed hunters 50% land area These are separate apportionments, Plus includes inland water area same formula is used to apportion funds. (States provide certification of licensed (square miles) Formula based on population compared to the total U.S. population using last census figures

> No state receives more than 3% or less than 1% of the total available


