#### Arivaca Cienega (AC)

wetland and groves of mesquite and hackberry trees. Arivaca Creek (Ck)

A 1-1/4 mile loop follows the seasonal stream under mesquite trees and majestic cottonwoods. Mustang Trail leaves the Creek Trail for a steep hike up El Cerro.

#### Brown Canyon (BC)

The canyon is open by guided walk only. Call for a schedule or to make reservations.

#### Semidesert Grasslands (Gr)

Most of the refuge is an extensive grassland with mesquite trees. Many southwestern birds can be sighted near the headquarters visitor center. (HQ). Wetlands (Wt)

In wet years, shorebirds and waterfowl may be seen in the grasslands at dirt tanks, natural wetlands, and the Aguirre Lake area.
