Florida School Registration

Eligibility

Kindergarten: Age 5 on or before September 1 (transfers from out-of-state may enroll)
Grade One: Age 6 on or before September 1 and completion of Kindergarten

Registration Requirement

Birth Certificate
Proof of Residency
Child's Social Security Number
Proof of Custody (if not biological parent)
Last Report Card, IEP and last School Withdrawal Form
Physical exam conducted in Florida
Immunization up to date including
2nd MMR
3 Hepatitis series

Attendance Area School is a school assignment based on the student's home address. Families do not need to complete an application for their children to attend or remain at their attendance area school.

Magnet Programs are elementary, middle and high schools with theme-based curriculum offering innovative and rigorous academic instruction by specially trained teachers in smaller learning communities.

School Choice provides parents and legal guardians with children entering grades K-11 the opportunity to choose up to three nonmagnet schools or Career & Technical Education programs. Parent may choose from a list of schools with space available.

Career & Technical Education offers technical training leading to high wage/high skill jobs and to further post secondary education.
