A United States Air Force Mobile Tour Experience

DESCRIPTION

- The U.S. Air Force is best known for flying, fighting and winning in the air. But in addition to the many flight careers, the branch also employs Airmen in over 130 careers, 51 of them dealing with multiple aspects of technology, mechanics, engineering and electronics.
- To show this collective power in action, we combined a team of seven highly specialized Airmen with a world-renowned team of car mechanics and customizers from Galpin Auto Sports. The result was Project: Supercar, a real-life showcase of Air Force ingenuity, state-of-the-art technology, imagination and input from some of the world's best mechanics.



HIGHLIGHTS

- Visitors are blown away when they see the tricked out car called the X-1. This fully customized Ford Mustang is all about power and speed, with a central drive system and a real F-16 ejection seat.
- Visitors can also engage in a 38' trailer filled with interactive touch screens showing how the cars were built and highlighting their specs.
- Interactive touch screen kiosks with iPad-like functionality are also onsite allowing visitors to check out a number of Air Force opportunities.
- Visitors are able to download unique content in the form of wallpapers, videos and ringtones to their cell phones or email.
