




Benefits of Using eSRS . Web-based system hosted on a secure public Website that is easily accessible from the Internet Allows electronic submission, acceptance, rejection,

- reporting and analysis of subcontracting data in a real-time, paperless environment Improves accuracy, timeliness and integrity of data

- Eliminates costs associated with manual data entry

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


eSRS Data Flow A contract must be marked in FPDS as having a subcontracting plan or it will NOT pull over to eSRS. If it is not marked correctly, the vendor will get an error message when trying to input an ISR and will be directed to contact their government contracting official. ****CARS Reporting*** Information from Central Contractor Registration is also sent to eSRS. Maintains a live interface to automatically populate basic vendor information using the DUNS number. Also maintains a live interface with Federal Procurement Data


system-Next Generation (FPDS-NG) to automatically populate contract data.

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



Inform your prime contractors that they, along with their subcontractors, are required to submit subcontract reports using eSRS for the April 2009 and all subsequent reporting periods.
