SUBJECT:	Amendment Number 1 to the 2012 Project Instructions – Coastal and Great Lakes Water Level Station Components

The National Weather Service (NWS) has reduced FY12 funding for the operation and maintenance of NWLON tsunami stations. Because of the reduced funding, annual inspections will not be performed at the following stations:

- 9442396 La Push, WA
- 9451054 Port Alexander, AK
- 9452634 Elfin Cove, AK
- 9457804 Alitak, AK
- 9459881 King Cove, AK
- 9461710 Atka, AK
- 9462450 Nikolski, AK

The station specific requirements listed for the above Washington and Alaska tsunami funded NWLON stations in Sections 2.16.4, 2.16.5, and 2.17 of PART C of the Project Instructions will not be accomplished. These requirements will remain documented in PART C for the development of next year's Project Instructions.

Additionally, the responsibility for operation and maintenance of the following four Alaskan stations in 2012 is transferred from POB to the Alaskan O&M contractor, JOA. The station specific requirements in Section 2.16.5 remain the same.

All other aspects of the January 2012 Project Instructions remain the same.
