The Appraisal Subcommittee (ASC) staff conducted an ASC Compliance Review (Review) of the Puerto Rico appraiser regulatory program (Program) on January 12-13, 2012. This is the final ASC Compliance Review Report (Report) on that Review.

The ASC has considered the preliminary findings regarding the Review and the State's response. Although the attached Report references an area of concern, the ASC has determined the Program is in substantial compliance with Title XI of the Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery, and Enforcement Act of 1989, as amended. Puerto Rico will be moved to a two-year Review Cycle. However, due to the lack of dedicated funding for the Program, ASC staff will make periodic contact with the Department and/or Board to allow for close monitoring of the Program.
