2. 6.5 hours of Human Cadaver Lab to include training in the following areas:

- Orthopedic
- Craniotomy
- Canthotomy and Nasopharyngeal Packing
- Ocular
- Airway Control
- Neck Exposures
- Ventriculostomy
- Extremity Fixation
- Fasciotomies
- Amputations
- Vascular Exposures

3. 2.5 hours of Animal Salvage Lab to include training in the following areas:

- Splendectomy
- Liver Damage Control
- Small Bowel Resection
- Renal and Urethral Repairs/Nephrectomy
- Vascular Control and Shunt Repair
- Cardiothoracic Exposures
