## VISA REQUIREMENTS IN MAURITIUS

DISCLAIMER: The information below relating to Mauritian legal requirements is provided for general information only and may not cover issues or details specific to a particular case. Questions involving interpretations of specific provisions or application to a specific case should be addressed to Mauritian government officials. The Embassy is not in a position to intercede with Mauritian authorities on behalf of Americans seeking entry into Mauritius.

Mauritius generally does not require visas for U.S. citizens coming to Mauritius for tourism/business purposes. Travelers should be in possession of a valid U.S. passport (with at least six months validity remaining), a return ticket reflecting departure from Mauritius within six months, and proof of adequate funds to demonstrate they can support themselves during their temporary stay in Mauritius.

Should you have questions regarding travel to Mauritius for other purposes, we suggest you contact the Mauritian Embassy in Washington, D.C., or the closest overseas Mauritian Embassy.
