You are invited to attend the Pacific Region Aerospace Education Officer School. This formal in-residence course will help you prepare for duties from the unit AEO through regional staff positions. The AEO Schools purpose is to help CAP officers execute the responsibilities and duties associated with aerospace education in Civil Air Patrol. Training modules include lectures and hands-on activities covering all aspects of the 215 Specialty Track. New AEOs will greatly benefit from this training as well as experienced AEOs learning about the new AE materials that are now available and to be released in the near future.

AEO School is taught by highly qualified individuals including: National and Regional Staff AE officers, Wing DAE officers and CAP members who are professionals in their careers. Instructors are carefully selected based on experience. The course will be conducted at the Texas Hotel / Casino conference center in north Las Vegas.

Special topics to be covered include:

- Steven Patti interview, a World War II CAP pilot who flew anti-submarine patrols in a Stinson 10A aircraft.
- Unveiling of a new CAP Stinson 10A Radio Controlled Aircraft for CAP members to purchase, build and fly themselves.
- New Aerospace Education Programs.
- How to have a successful and dynamic AE program in your unit at any level.
