MAMC PHARMACEUTICAL CENTER

Overview



The Department of Pharmacy is made up of a team of dedicated healthcare workers composed of Registered Pharmacists, Pharmacy Technicians, Administrative and Supply Management personnel, and Red Cross volunteers. This cohesive team is dispersed throughout MAMC's patient care areas rendering pharmaceutical services to both inpatient and ambulatory patients. This team is responsible for the management of medication therapy provided at

MAMC, to include product quality control and assurance, monitoring of medication storage sites, ongoing evaluation of new medications, preparation and dispensing of medications, automation support, clinical screening for drug interactions, participating in clinical research, proving drug information to healthcare workers and the education of patients and family members.

Some of the services we provide on a daily bases are:

- The supply team manages over 3,000 pharmaceutical line items.
- The ambulatory care pharmacy team cares for over 2,000 patients.
- The ambulatory team processes over 5,000 new and refill prescriptions.
- The ambulatory team generates approximately 90 drug interventions with providers to ensure our patients receive the best therapy possible.
- Clinic pharmacists in collaboration with MAMC healthcare staff provide direct patient care activities in medication management services.
- The inpatient care pharmacy team provides continuous services to patients in the hospital 24-hours a day.
- The inpatient team processes over 500 sterile products for intravenous administration to patients on in-house units.
- Unit pharmacists provide direct patient care activities with other healthcare members (physicians and nurses).
- Certified pharmacists work in specialty clinics providing direct patient care services in Oncology, Cardiology, Nuclear, Nephrology, and Investigational.
