To order portraits of your children, go to **WWW.CPIphoto.net**, click on **Order Now**. You may also use the order form that will be sent home several days prior to our picture day; you may also use the facsimile included with this letter.

• There are two ways to make your package selection in advance. **Online** use your credit or debit card. On picture day, pay using the **order envelope** and check, money order or cash.

If not ordering online:

- Return the envelope and payment with your child **on** the photo date. (Do not return the order envelope if you order online.)
- Your child, order envelope, and payment must arrive together at the camera. Students MUST HAVE PAYMENT with them on photo day or their photo is considered "yearbook only."
- Please use *one envelope per student*, **NOT** one envelope for multiple children.
- Please make checks payable to CAMPUS PHOTOGRAPHY, **NOT** the school.
- Post-dated checks up to two weeks are accepted.
- Only pre-paid orders are produced and returned to school. *All* photographs are ultimately taken for inclusion in the school yearbook.

Your satisfaction is guaranteed or Campus Photography assures us you will receive a 100 percent refund. This program allows a faster return of the finished package.
