Net EITC is after math error posting and subsequent adjustment, including CP09/27. It indicates the following:

After adjustments for:

1. Math error processing, which involves computerized checks for mathematical and clerical errors during standard tax return processing. This involves checks for arithmetic mistakes and errors in reading tax and EITC tables, but also includes checks for valid taxpayer identification numbers; and after adjustments for

2. Potentially eligible EITC claimants, resulting from

a. A CP 09 notice, issued to low income taxpayers with qualifying children who appear to qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) but did not claim it on their original return; (these taxpayers are EITC potentially eligible).

b. A CP 27 notice, issued to low income taxpayers without qualifying children who appear to qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) but did not claim it on their original return; (these taxpayers are EITC potentially eligible).

CP is an abbreviation for computer paragraph
