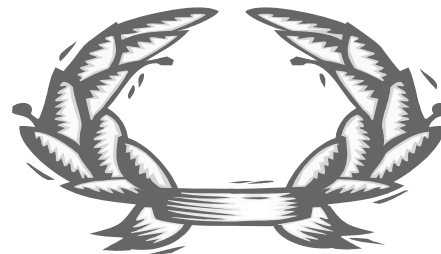

GRADING SYSTEM/RANK IN CLASS

The marking system uses letter grades, which are converted to grade point value. Advanced Placement courses are given a weighted grade. Calculation of student academic standing is based on grade point average (GPA) and includes all courses, which are recorded on transcripts.
