Reporting Options

Unrestricted Reporting

- -Report made through the chain of command, legal, and law enforcement
- Victim receives medical treatment and support

Restricted Reporting

- Title 10 and Full time NG -Report to
- SARC/VA/MD/Chaplain
- -Does not Trigger an Investigation

- -Commanders can provide: Military Protection order, Separation, Criminal Investigation
- -Offender held accountable
- -Victim receives medical treatment and support
- Command receives nonidentifying information

Limited Reporting - Available for NG SM when not on AD
