Operations Security (OPSEC) - an analytical process used to deny our adversaries unclassified — but sensitive - information concerning our intentions and capabilities by identifying, controlling, and protecting indicators associated with our planning processes or operations.

*A past study revealed the following information risks, in order of severity, were:

- 1. Loose Talk
- 2. Careless Paper Handling
- 3. Computer Systems.

OPSEC is our first line of defense against intelligence collection!

Protect Critical
Information (CI):
(Critical facts which could reveal sensitive details of the mission.)

- Planned Operations
- Current Operations
- Capabilities and Limitations

Apply OPSEC to:

- -Military Operations "Loose Lips, Sink Ships"
- -Personal Activities "Loose Lips, Helps Thieves'
- -Professional Activities "Loose Lips, Sink Jobs"

Know Your Critical Information and Protect it!
