Reporting Options

Unrestricted Reporting

- Report made through the chain of command, legal, and law enforcement
- Victim receives medical treatment and support
- Commanders can provide: Military Protection order, Separation, Criminal Investigation
- Offender held accountable

Restricted Reporting

- Title 10 and Full time NG
- Report to SARC/VA/MD/Chaplain
- Does not Trigger an Investigation
- Victim receives medical treatment and support
- Command receives non-identifying information

Limited Reporting – Available for NG SM when not on AD
