Operations Security (OPSEC) - *an analytical process used to deny our adversaries unclassified – but sensitive - information concerning our intentions and capabilities by identifying, controlling, and protecting indicators associated with our planning processes or operations.*

**A past study revealed the following information risks, in order of severity, were:*

- 1. Loose Talk*
- 2. Careless Paper Handling*
- 3. Computer Systems.*

OPSEC is our first line of defense against intelligence collection!

Protect Critical Information (CI):
(Critical facts which could reveal sensitive details of the mission.)

- Planned Operations*
- Current Operations*
- Capabilities and Limitations*

- Professional Activities
"Loose Lips, Sink Jobs"*
