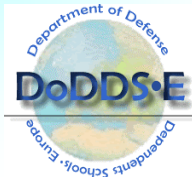

Have you checked out your 4th or 5th grade student's GradeSpeed account? DoDEA implemented an online gradebook application for grades 4-12. A powerful feature of this application is the ability of parents to access their child's assignments and grades online. The goal of this implementation is to increase parent communication and to encourage parents to take a more active role in their child's education. Contact the school to learn how to set up an account!

Students in grades 4 and 5 are given accounts to the Student Connection program, which allows them to see any grades entered in GradeSpeed. This information is provided to them at school and they see exactly what you see.

- Call DSN 475-ROAD (7623) or civilian 09641-83-7623 for the recorded road conditions and reporting instructions.

MEMORANDUM FOR BAVARIA DISTRICT SCHOOLS

SUBJECT: Inclement Weather Policy

On late fall, winter, and early spring days when there is inclement weather (i.e., rain, snow, heavy winds, etc.), or when the air temperature falls below freezing (32°F/O°C) the following practices will be expected:

- 1) All students are to be properly dressed for the prevailing weather conditions. This attire should include hats, weather-appropriate coats and jackets, gloves, and shoes. This is a responsibility of the student and parent. Please include this information in school newsletters, etc., throughout the school year as a reminder.
- 2) Students who walk to school should adjust departure times from home to ensure arrival time at school coincides with the time(s) the school doors will be open for student entry.
- 3) Doors to the school are to be open to students at least ten (10) minutes prior to normal opening times. This will allow students to enter the building and assemble in pre-determined and supervised areas (i.e., near classrooms or in pre-designated common areas).
- 4) Students arriving by bus, whereas the school is the last stop for the bus, will remain on the bus until the school doors are open for student entry. Drivers and school personnel will release students from the bus when entrance to the school building is possible.
- 5) The decision as to have outdoor versus indoor recess activities rests with the classroom teacher and school administration. A 'common sense' factor regarding the weather conditions must be followed in the appropriateness of outdoor versus indoor activities. The temperature and other weather conditions should serve as a guideline. Indoor activities require advance planning by teachers and administration in order to be successful.
- 6) This policy will be reviewed on an ongoing basis to make sure that the safety and needs of students are properly being addressed.
