AUDITORIUM

The 1,700 square foot auditorium has the versatility to accommodate symposiums, educational presentations, cultural events, award ceremonies, and other types of programs.

The Gerald R. Ford Presidential Library is part of the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). Accordingly, the use of the grounds and facilities are governed by federal rules and regulations, requiring adherence to certain guidelines.

Events must be related to the mission and programs of the Library, and be consistent with the public perception of the Library as a research, educational, professional and cultural institution. Personal, commercial, profit-making, political fundraisers or sales activities are not permitted. No auctions, raffles, or registration fees collected at the door, sales promotion of goods and/or services, or cash bars are allowed on site. Alcoholic beverages are permitted in an open bar setting only. The serving of alcohol must end no later than one half hour before the conclusion of the event. Smoking and open flames are not permitted anywhere in the building or on the grounds.

The following guidelines apply to the Gerald Ford Presidential Library:

- Parking Parking is usually available in the Blue University lot across the street from the library. Fees may apply.
- Weekends The library does not generally offer facility usage on weekends or federal holidays.
- Wireless The library does not currently have wireless capability.
