SUBJECT: New Priority 2/3 Guidance

In accordance with DOD 4500.43 and the new USTRANSCOM INSTRUCTION 10-19 (dated 1 July 04) during the periods of war, the OSA system provides airlift as required to support wartime efforts.

In keeping with this guidance, effective immediately, validators should assign Priority 2 to airlift requests with compelling operational considerations and/or time constraints. For example, general officers/senior federal officials and senior field commanders engaged in mobilization and planning for the war fight whose schedules are time constrained can be considered a compelling operational consideration.

In accordance with USTRANSCOM INSTRUCTION 10-19, for Priority 3 requirements, requestors should allow at least +/- 12 hours flexibility in departure/arrival times to maximize airlift supportability. Requestors may state desired tighter time frames (ie +/- 4 hours), but JOSAC may not be able to meet the requested times.
