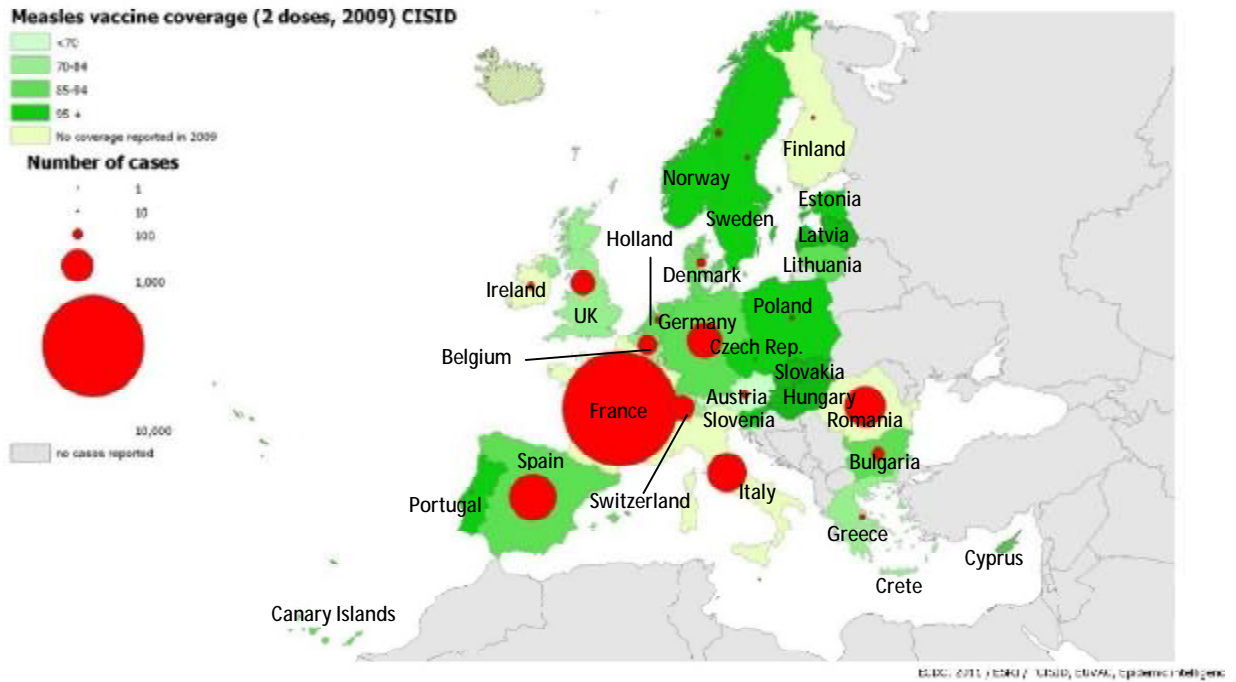

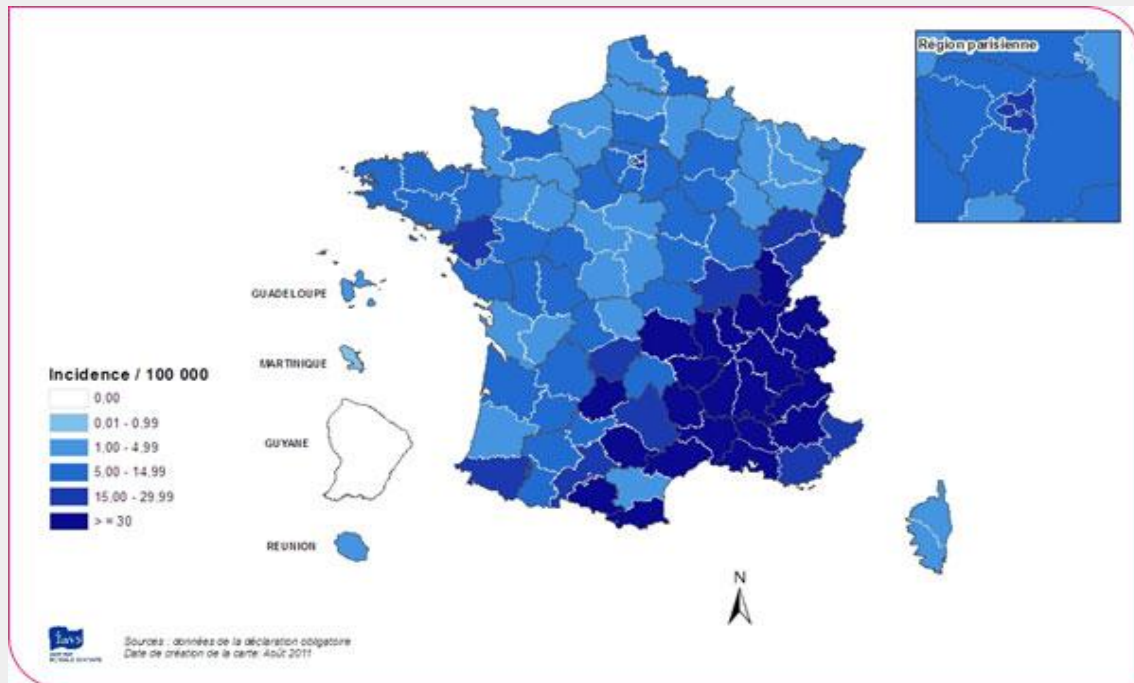

### Geographical distribution of measles cases from July 2010 to June 2011

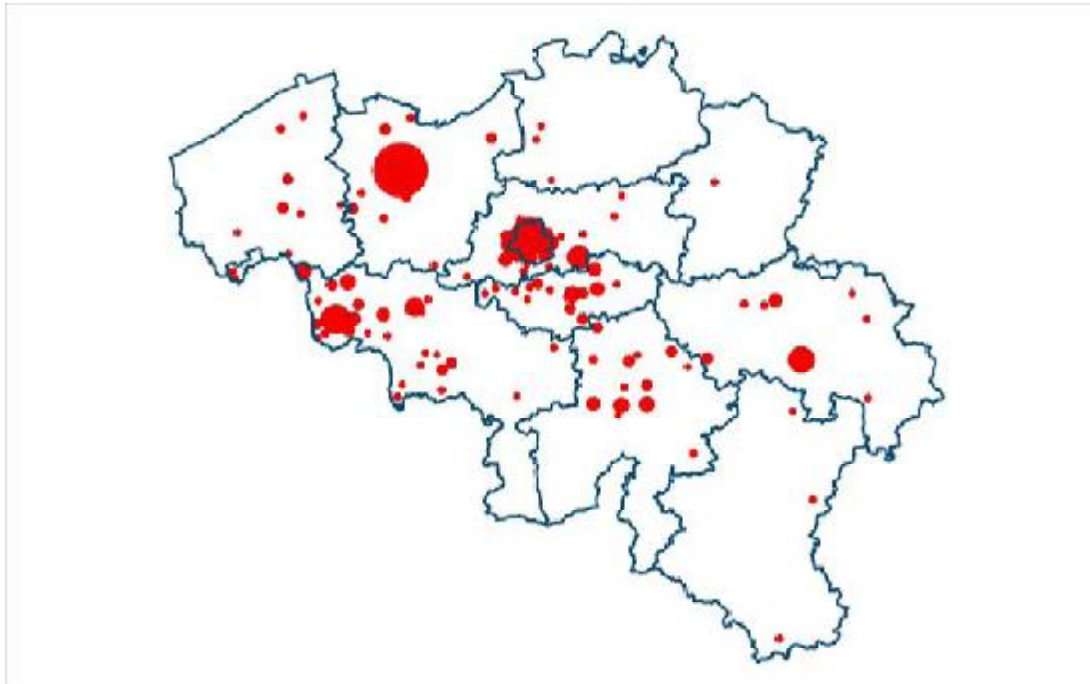
The most elevated incidence rates are still observed in the South East part of France. The incidence rate has also increased in the region of Paris (See top right corner)

Distribution of measles cases by province; Belgium, January 2007–May 2011



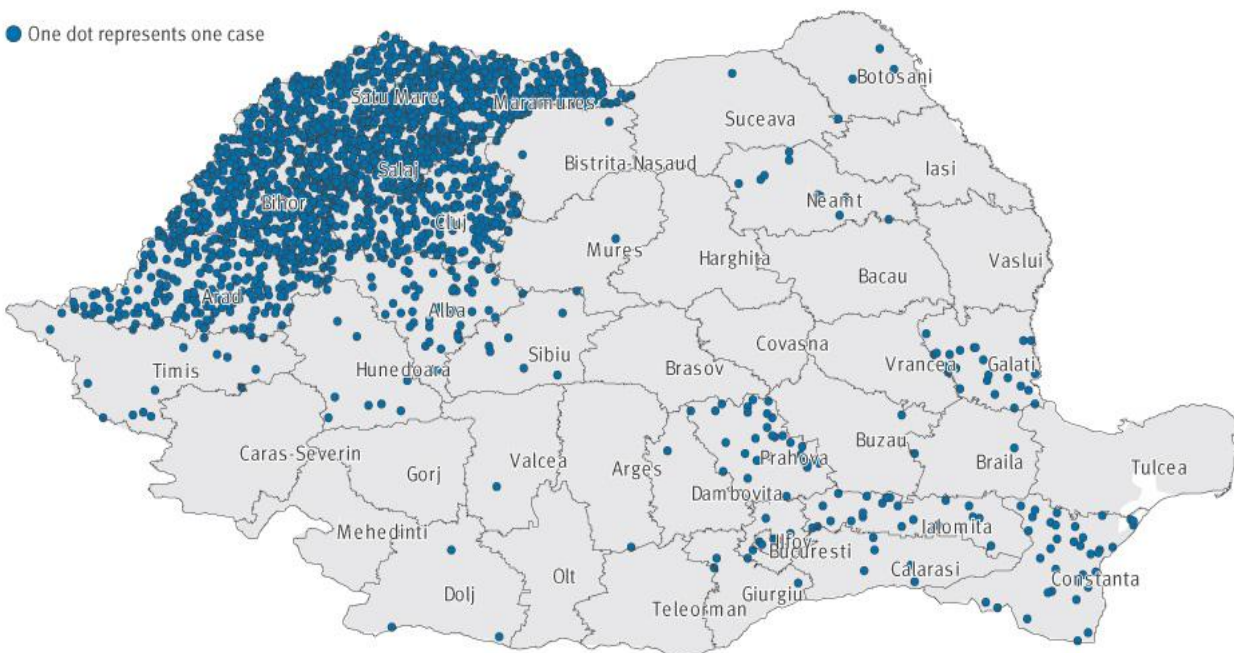
