- **Task**

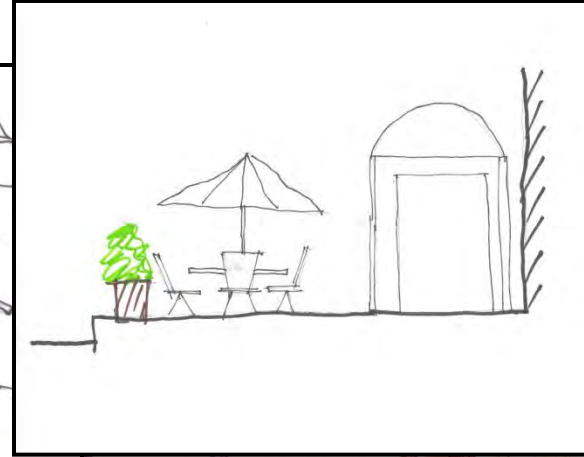
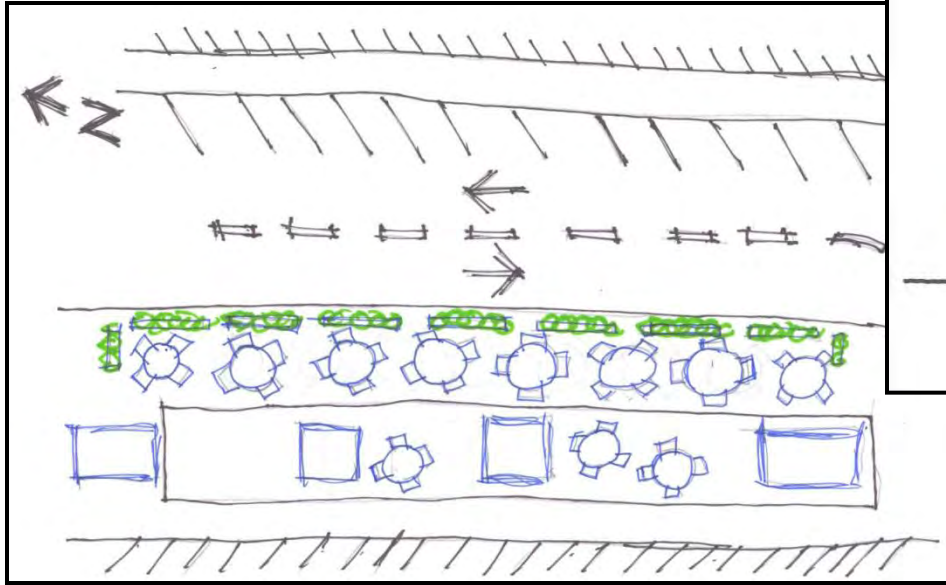
- get more lunch spots and make Ederle look better.

Your POL coupons expire each year on 30 September, which affects your coupon purchases during the months of September and October. Note the following conditions:

2010-2011 POL coupons are valid through 30 September.

2010-2011 POL coupons will be refunded 21 September through 30 November 2011 only.

- *Price of refund will be price of purchase. If the price cannot be determined, the lowest purchase point of sale will be used.*
- *Coupons must be in fair condition - serial numbers and denominations must be legible.*

Exception: Customers deployed during refund period. Orders must be presented in order to receive refund.

If you are unable to visit an Exchange within Italy during the refund period, please send your 2010-2011 POL coupons to:

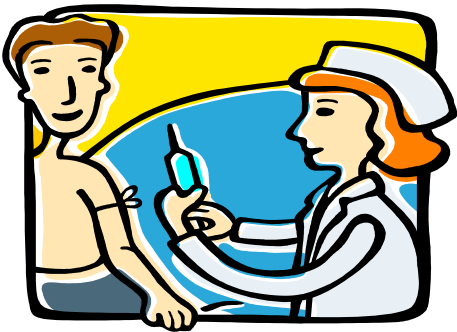
