
We assist with the resolution of issues that come through the Army Wounded Soldier and Family Hotline (WSFH).

## Open Issue DES 10-636 Installation Access Policy for Civilian Retirees

**Scope**: I am a retired DoD civilian. I have a US bank account at Global Credit Union. For the past 3 years my wife and I have been issued an installation pass so that we can conduct business with the Global Credit Union on post. Recently when we submitted a renewal request for my wife's pass, it was denied.

#### I have two questions:

- 1. What is the Command Policy for Issuing Installation passes for retired DoD civilians who have a legitimate need to access the post?
- 2. Has there been a change in Command Policy for issuance of Installation Passes for retired civilians?

**Recommendations:** Continue to issue installation passes to retired DoD civilians who have a legitimate need to access post. A legitimate need could be work as a volunteer or need to conduct bank business with the local US bank on post.





## Open Issue DES 10-636 (continued) Installation Access Policy for Civilian Retirees

Agency Response: <u>DES</u>: Installation access is granted under AER 190-16. Any of the 17 categories can meet the justification requirement for the pass and badge office to issue an installation access badge; however, all requests for access that do not fall in the categories outlined in AER 190-16 must be submitted in memorandum format to the Garrison Commander for exception to policy. The Garrison Commander will then coordinate with the Italian Base Commander for all exceptions to policy that fall outside the US regulatory authority and SOFA status for exception to policy access authorization to the Vicenza Military Community.

A requirement for conducting bank business on post is not one of the 17 categories for installation access authorization overseas in Europe.





## **Open Issue DES 10-639 MP Issuing Parking Tickets**

**Scope:** The issuing of parking tickets on post needs to be consistent and use common sense. For one thing EVERYONE knows that parking is a problem on post. There are not enough legal spaces and ongoing construction often blocks many parking spaces for weeks or months at a time. People that work on post have the most problems with parking. We have to be here throughout the day and would like to park near our offices. Sometimes this means we have to park at the end of a line of cars which may not actually be a designated spot, but in no way impedes anything. The fact that white lines are not present is arbitrary. This ticketing situation is even worse b/c the MPs only give tickets to Active military and dependants. Local Nationals are not affected. They can seemingly park where ever or however they want.

**Recommendations:** Be consistent and use common sense. Local Nationals should have the same consequences for parking as everyone else.

**Agency Response:** <u>DES</u>: Parking violations will continue to be enforced as long as resources allow for this to occur while still performing the additional required community law enforcement missions.





## Open Issue DES 10-641 Brief MPs on Bus Stop Safety

**Scope:** MP's need to be briefed on bus stop safety.

**Recommendations:** Add crossing guard volunteers.

**Agency Response:** <u>DES</u>: The new PMO NCOIC has implemented a printed guard instruction briefing and pass-on plan for the MPs performing this mission, in an effort to ensure no one can claim they do not understand their duties. However, I agree with your recommendation to transfer this mission to crossing guard volunteers under a program implemented by the school. I will pass this recommendation to the school liaison officer and Garrison CSM for consideration and will plan on continuing to support this mission as long as the ODT MP augmentees are available.





## Open Issue DES/DPW 10-640 Street Behind DFAC

**Scope:** The street behind the DFAC/AFN parking lot where cars make a left turn needs to have a stop sign. There was almost an accident where a jeep didn't see a soldier jogging. This area has a blind spot.

**Recommendations:** Put stop sign in this area to make people stop.

**Agency Response:** <u>DPW:</u> This is an excellent suggestion. We have coordinated with DES as well as the requestor. We will have a stop sign installed near the northwest corner of building 10 (AFN/DFAC) by 15 March.

<u>DES:</u> DES concurs with recommendation with the addition of consideration of a crosswalk. DES has coordinated with DPW and DPW will proceed with follow-up action to evaluate and execute this recommendation, if approved by the Garrison Commander.





#### Open Issue DPW 10-637 Lines/Markings on the Roads on Post

**Scope:** The road lines on post are very faint. When it is raining, which it does often here, the center line and the outside lines are invisible it seems. When they repainted the parking space lines in the PX and Commissary I along with many others were hoping that meant the roads would be repainted also. The road should have been done BEFORE the parking lines in my opinion.

**Recommendations:** I recommend that the center and outside lines of the roads be repainted.

**Agency Response:** <u>DPW</u>: The Garrison has a plan in which all road markings get repainted every two years. Last fiscal year we repainted many "Stop" markings, intersections and cross walks. This year we will repaint all markings not done last year. This will include the center lines and outside lines on the streets. In addition we are using a new paint with better reflectivity than the paint we have used in the past. Finally, in many light traffic areas, road markings and especially cross walks wear very quickly. We attempt to repaint those more often. Your help in that area to bring those to our attention when they occur will be appreciated.





#### Open Issue DPW 10-642 Scout Hut on Ederle

**Scope: Scout Hut on Ederle** 

**Recommendations:** The scouts have requested a hut.

**Agency Response:** <u>DPW:</u> As the elementary school moves to Villaggio in August 2010, some space near the existing school at Ederle will become available. We are looking at the feasibility of making some of this space available for the scouts.
