 - Bus stop on Post Across Shoppette parking lot






Candy Plan

DES Mission

From 1530-UTC Hours, 29 OCT 2010, DES and SETAF Carabinieri will execute a security plan to ensure the Safety and Security of all personnel attending the Halloween activities by providing Fire Safety, Emergency Services, Access Control, and providing a proactive Combined Security Patrol presence throughout the evening.





PEDESTRIAN ACCESS CONTROL

- ➤ US, NATO ID Card Holders, and Local Nationals with Installation Passes may enter at Villaggio Front Gate or Villaggio Self Help Gate with the shuttle bus.
- ➤ Local Nationals without Installation Passes must enter at Villaggio Front Gate from 1900-2030 HRS. SETAF Carabinieri / Civis have responsibility for identifying and screening Local Nationals and Third Country National Visitors. Military Police are responsible for US Personnel. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.





RESTRICTIONS

- ➤ Villaggio Housing Area roads will be closed to nonessential / emergency traffic from 1800 – 2100
- ➤ No roller blades, roller skates, skateboards, bicycles, mopeds, motorcycles, sharp objects, other items that may be considered dangerous, or pets are allowed on the event grounds
- No inappropriate clothing (offensive, anti-American, or No Dal Molin) will be worn in the area
- No alcohol / glass bottles allowed in the area
- Residents that have domesticated animals will have them indoors or secured in a fenced yard

Nov. 6 – 7: Festa dei Ossi de Mascio (Pig bones festival), Sarego, about 16 miles southwest of Vicenza, at the sports center in Piazza Don Stefano Lago. Food booths featuring risotto with <i>tastasale</i> (minced pork, garlic, and rosemary), pork sausage, and pig bones.
Nov. 6 – 8: San Martino Fair, Velo D'Astico, about 26 miles northwest of Vicenza. Local produce and crafts exhibit and sale, food booths, and live entertainment.
Nov. 12 – 14: San Martino Festival and Snails Festival, Ponte di Barbarano Vicentino, 13 miles south of Vicenza. Gastronomical stands, mushroom exhibition, raffle, costume parade, entertainment for children, live music, and fireworks.
Nov. 14: Marroni e Vin Novo (Chestnuts and new wine celebration), Lonigo, about 20 miles southwest of Vicenza. Food booths and entertainment.
Nov. 20 – 24: Christmas Market , Bassano del Grappa, about 22 miles northeast of Vicenza.
Nov. 25: Saint Catherine Festival and <i>Mandorlato</i> (Almond nougat) Fair, Lusiana, about 24 miles north of Vicenza. Food stands, roasted chestnuts, live
