Are you interested in applying to study your undergraduate degree in the Monday, December 25: Christmas Day United States in Fall 2012?

If you answered yes to the above questions, you should apply for the Competitive College Club at EducationUSA! The Competitive College Club is an EducationUSA small group advising program that assists high school students who want to apply to U.S. universities.

Students will work together as a closeknit community during the application process. The club will meet twice monthly during the school year and participate in lectures, book clubs, community service activities, cross cultural exercises and will prepare for admissions exams. The activities will prepare students both academically and socially for a U.S. university. Topics will include determining which schools and majors might be a good fit, U.S. cultural and academic knowledge, writing application essays, visa paperwork, financial aid resources and more. This program is for all students who have the academic background and motivation to attend U.S. universities.



1. Undergraduate Scholarship:

University of Oregon Scholarships for

International Students

International Affairs, University of Oregon awards over one million dollars in scholarships to UO international students each year. Tuition, cash and work-study awards are available. Selection is based on financial need and academic merit.

Scholarships are available in the following areas:

- International Cultural Service Program (ICSP): 30 new tuition scholarships of \$6,000-\$20,000.
- International Dean's Excellence Award (IDEA): 40 tuition scholarships ranging from \$4,000-\$6,000.
- International Affairs Endowed Scholarships: 20 cash scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$10,000.
- International Student Work-Study Program: 80 work-study awards ranging form \$500-\$3,000.
