

LEAP Managers award Special Experience Identifiers to 427 participants

The Air Force Culture and Language Center's Language Enabled Airman Program managers recently selected 427 LEAP participants to receive LEAP Special Experience Identifier codes. These LEAP SEIs will be added to participants' official Military Personnel Data System records. Having the LEAP SEI allows Air Force personnel managers to be aware of an Airman's foreign language proficiency, and helps those managers match abilities with current and future operational needs.

Award of LEAP SEIs is independent of the Foreign Language Proficiency Bonus program, which is managed by the Air Force Language, Region and Culture Program Office (AF/A1DV-LRC). These LEAP SEIs will have an effective date of Oct. 1. LEAP participants should check their Single Unit Retrieval Format record (SURF) in MilPDS to determine if an SEI has been awarded.
