

CONTROL COMMUNICATIONS

COL Jonas Vogelhut, born in Brooklyn, NY, is a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh, PA, where he earned his bachelor's of science degree in chemistry. His early assignments include Platoon Leader, Armor Battalion Assistant S-3 Operations Officer/Battalion Chemical Officer and Infantry Brigade Assistant S-3 Operations Officer/Brigade Chemical Officer. Later, he commanded the 92d Chemical Company, which was awarded the Sibert Award for best Chemical Company in the Army during his tenure in command.

COL Vogelhut transitioned to the Acquisition Corps, where he served as Chemical Materiel Branch Chief, Maneuver Support Center, Fort Leonard Wood, MO, then as Executive Officer, Program Executive Office, Command, Control, and Communications Tactical (PEO C3T), Fort Monmouth, NJ. Continuing with PEO C3T, he served as Assistant Program Manager, Force XXI Battle Command Brigade and Below (FBCB2). During this assignment, he was attached to the 3d Infantry Division, Iraq, and participated in combat during Operations Enduring and Iraqi Freedom.

Moving on to the Pentagon, COL Vogelhut served as a Department of the Army Systems Coordinator for Joint and Army Battle Command Systems, such as the Joint Tactical Radio System (JTRS) and the Global Command and Control System- Army (GCCS-A). Returning to a leadership role, he next served as Joint Product Manager, Reconnaissance and Platform Integration. Later, COL Vogelhut worked as the Operations Officer for PEO Intelligence, Electronics Warfare, and Sensors.

COL Vogelhut's education includes the Chemical Officer Advanced Course, where he earned the Distinguished Honor Graduate Award, the Naval Postgraduate School, where he earned a master's degree in systems management and acquisition and was named the Distinguished Department of Defense graduate, and the U.S. Army War College. COL Vogelhut's acquisition certifications include level three in both Program Management and Test and Evaluation, and level two in Information Technology and Systems Planning, Research Development, and Engineering.

COL Vogelhut's awards include the Bronze Star, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with Three Oak Leaf Clusters, the Iraqi Campaign Medal with Three Stars, the Southwest Asia Service Ribbon with One Bronze Star, the Presidential Unit Citation, the Superior Unit Award Decoration with Two Oak Leaf Clusters, and the Army Staff Identification Badge.
