WHAT: July Fourth Spectacular and Army Community Covenant Signing

WHEN: 8 a.m. until Midnight, July 4

WHERE: Sills Field, Schofield Barracks

DETAILS: Schofield Barracks invites the public to the Army’s 37th Annual Fourth of July Spectacular on Sills Field. Organizers expect approximately 50,000 people to attend the celebration.

Highlights this year include a free concert by country singer Billy Ray Cyrus, followed by a Community Covenant signing ceremony and fireworks finale.

Covenant signatories include Governor Linda Lingle, several state legislators, a Medal of Honor Recipient, as well as civic, community and military leaders.

All four gates to Schofield will be open to the public from 8 a.m. to midnight.

Due to security requirements, photo identification will be required to enter the post. All vehicles, backpacks and coolers will be subject to search.

Attendees are reminded to leave pets and high back chairs at home, as they will not be allowed on Sills Field. Additionally, fireworks, sparklers, glass containers and firearms are not permitted.

Media is welcome to cover the event from specially reserved locations directly in front of the concert stage.
