DETAILS: U.S. Army Garrison-Hawaii would like to invite the public when it introduces seven new names into the U.S. Army Museum of Hawaii's Gallery of Heroes, at Fort DeRussy. The ceremony will honor the distinguished service of Hawaii Soldiers from WWII, Korea and Vietnam.

Since 1980, the gallery has honored local service men and women who have received one of the nation's two highest awards for valor, the Congressional Medal of Honor and the Distinguished Service Cross, or its equivalents, the Navy Cross or the Air Force Cross.

Those being inducted are Capt. Robert M. Caliboso, Capt. Linus G. Chock, Sgt. Douglas G Factora, Pvt. Paulino E. Hernaez, Staff Sgt. George S. Iida, Staff Sgt. Edward N. Kaneshiro, and 1st Lt. John K. Kauhahao.

The museum is located at the intersection of Saratoga and Kalia Roads in Waikiki. Limited parking is available in the pay parking lot across from the museum. Parking discounts are available through parking stub validation in the museum gift shop.
