Living History Day

HONOLULU—The U.S. Army Museum of Hawaii is bringing history to life with Living History Day, May 16 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., at Fort DeRussy in Waikiki.

This free event, held in conjunction with Armed Forces Day, is open to the public and offers a fun-filled and educational day for all ages.

Visitors can talk with current Soldiers about daily life or deployment experiences, as well as tour hands-on exhibits of weapons, equipment, vehicles and insignia from ancient Hawaii through modern day.

Re-enactors will share the history behind their uniforms, equipment and weapons. Large-scale, working vintage aircraft models will be on display.

Participating organizations include the 25th Infantry Division, the Hawaii Historic Arms Association, the Hawaii Military Vehicle Preservation Association, the Civil War Roundtable, Birds of Paradise (aircraft modelers), Pearl Harbor Historic Partners and the Celtic Pipes and Drums of Hawaii.
