Gate construction at Tripler

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii—Beginning January 10, inbound traffic lanes at Tripler Army Medical Center’s main gate, on Jarrett White Road, will temporarily be reduced as part of a construction project improve traffic flow.

The construction project is designed to improve traffic flow by adding a third inbound traffic lane to TAMC’s main gate. Currently there are two inbound traffic lanes.

During the first phase of construction, the right inbound traffic lane will be closed from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., for approximately one month. Motorists should expect potential delays and plan accordingly. The lane will not be closed during rush hour commute times.

Army officials will monitor the traffic flow during the construction and make adjustments, if necessary.

There will be no impact to outgoing traffic.
