Army gives all clear after bomb threat

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii –UPDATE: After a thorough search of the C-Quad area at Schofield Barracks nothing was discovered. As of 4:29 p.m. the all clear has been given and Macomb gate has been reopened.

Army security and Explosive Ordnance Disposal personnel searched the vicinity of C-Quad barracks after receiving a bomb threat at 12:40 p.m. today.

C-Quad is on Waianae Avenue on Schofield Barracks parallel to Wilikina Drive.

Military police are continuing to investigate the incident.
