Army searching for suspicious male on Schofield Barracks

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Army, state and federal authorities are searching for a high-risk, suspicious individual on Schofield Barracks after receiving a threat via telephone at 10:18, today.

Army authorities have confirmed that the threat is a domestic issue between a male suspect and his girlfriend. Schofield Barracks is currently at a heightened state of alert. Community is advised to stay alert and report any suspicious activity to 655-7114 or 438-7114. There is no specific threat to any of the schools; however, as a precautionary measure, Solomon and Hale Kula Elementary School have been locked down and are sheltering in place.
