

Fort Gordon Environmental Quality Control Committee (EQCC)

FACT SHEET

INTRODUCTION In accordance with paragraph 15-2a - c, Army Regulation 200-1, each major command and installation will establish an Environmental Quality Control Committee.

Who are the members? The membership consist of representatives of the operational, logistics, engineering, planning, resource management, legal, medical, environmental, morale, welfare, and recreation, commissary, exchange service and safety interests of the command, including military installation tenant activities.

What is its function? The EQCC provides a forum to address, enhance and resolve environmental issues.

What is the purpose? The purpose of the EQCC is to help plan, execute and monitor actions and programs with environmental implications and identify issues, make recommendations and advise the Garrison Commander.

Who conducts the EQCC? The Directorate of Public Works (DPW), Environmental Division conducts the meetings under the guidance of the DPW Director.

When does the EQCC meet? Quaterly. Members are notified as far in advance as possible.
