What is SAC? The School Advisory Committee (SAC) is a forum of interested students, parents, and faculty who meet quarterly to communicate recommendations, concerns or advice to the principal on educational matters. SAC doesn't make school policy. It is an advisory board. In advising the principal, we represent the views of BMHS students, parents, and teachers.

What Can SAC do? SAC's purpose is to enhance educational programs, support services, and quality of life for BMHS students. SAC addresses issues involving instructional programs and resources, pupil services, standards of conduct and discipline, school policies, activities, and admin procedures. We don't address individual faculty/student issues. The SAC focuses on general problems or policy issues.

Who can come to the meetings? Students, parents, and faculty members are all encouraged to attend the meetings which are scheduled for: 5 Nov. 2012, 4 Feb. 2013, and 1 Apr. 2013. The meetings are held in the big conference room and begin at 15:30.
