What an Applicant Should Expect on Interview Day

On the day of the interview, applicants are required to arrive at the Islamabad Convention Center 30 minutes before their interview appointment. At the Convention Center, the applicant will board a shuttle bus that will bring them to the Consular section's reception area. The guards will then conduct a security screening and lead the applicants inside the Consular section one by one.

Fingerprinting

Once inside the Consular section, applicants will queue for the ten-print fingerprinting process. An example of the fingerprinting process is below:

The Interview

After fingerprinting is complete, applicants will have a seat in the waiting room until the interviewing officer calls them up for the interview. At the time of the interview, the applicants are supposed to keep any supporting documents with them until the interviewing officer asks for them. The interview is a conversation between the officer and the applicant. Applicants should answer the officer's questions with as much detail as they can provide, and present additional documents to the officer only if requested.
